- Ensuring that volunteers are thanked and that their contribution is valued
- Ensuring a mentoring focus throughout Wear it Purple's teams, with opportunities for feedback and relevant professional development
- Ensuring that educational opportunities or dialogue with the wider community is informed and respectful
- Ensuring that Wear it Purple is both innovative in its projects and collaborative with other organisations where possible, treating the work of other organisations with respect
