



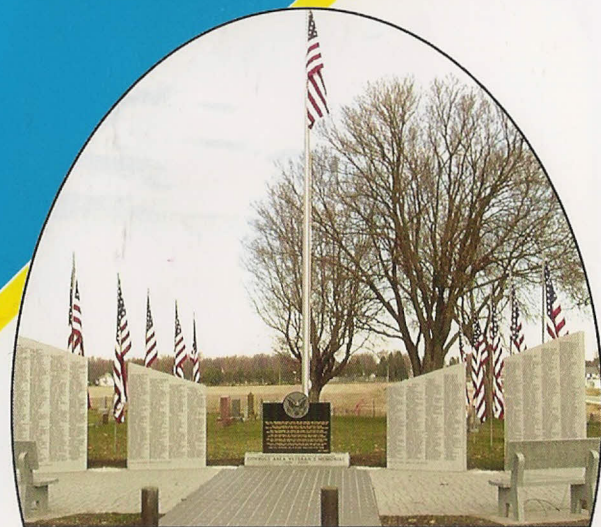
Memorial Walk

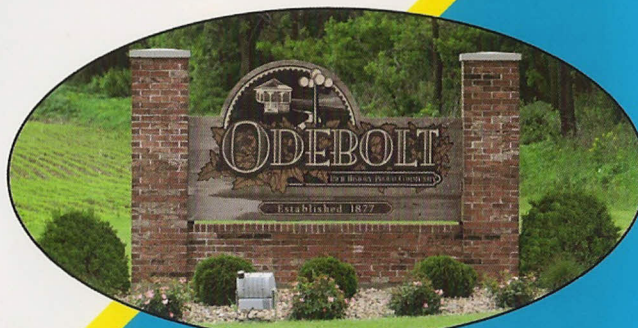
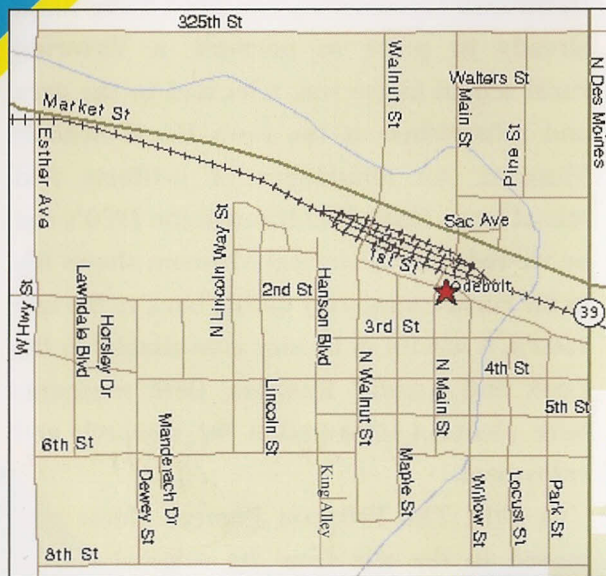
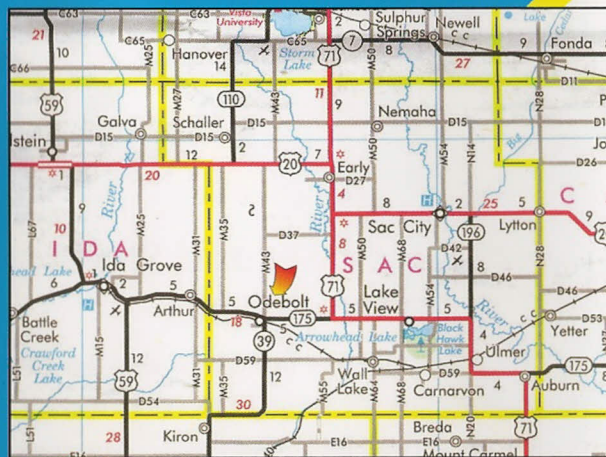
Refreshments or meals are available at Cubby's, Sparky's, or The Bowling Alley Restaurant.

Overnight accommodations may be reserved at the RV Park or Travelers' Home. Call City Hall for more information.

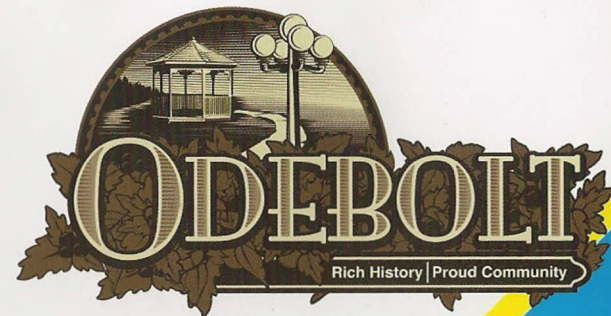


Veterans' Memorial

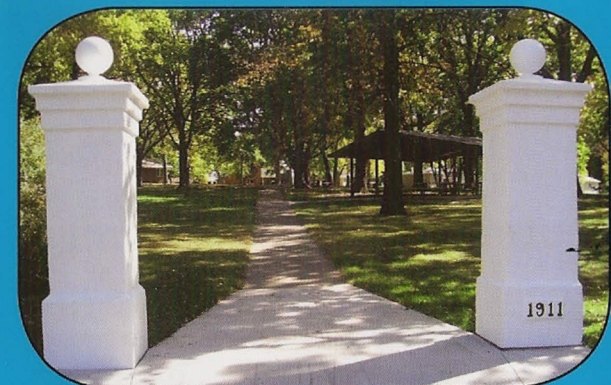

Located on Second Street Odebolt, Iowa

In 2011 ground was broken to develop the Heritage Square on Second Street in Odebolt. With the Odebolt Historical Museum, Downtown Greenspace, and First State Bank already in place as anchors, a Victorian rural school house was relocated to the area and refurbished as the Iowa Rural Schools Museum. An abundance of artifacts and school items from 1883 through the 1950's can be viewed. The Historical Museum shows life in the rural community dating back to the late 1800's. A wealth of history is available on the Cook and Adams' Ranches. Both museums have plentiful information for research and enjoyment.

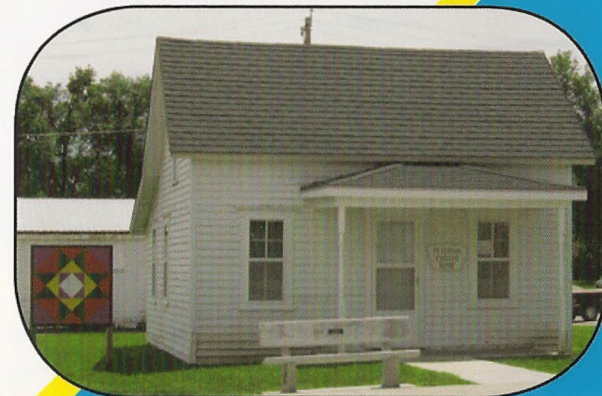
In 2012 The Peterson Pioneer Home was moved to the site from its original setting on Walnut Street. It is a fine example of an 1886 pioneer home for a family of seven that remains in its "almost" original condition.

The First State Bank is a spectacular structure which was home to the Adams' Ranch office in the early 1900's and a setting for the movie *Peacock* in 2010. The historical room exhibits items from the bank's history.

In close proximity are the Carnegie Library built in 1904 and Monument Circle which commemorates World War I.
