MEMORANDUM FOR Cadets Invited to Return for School Year 2013-2014

SUBJECT: Leadership Development Course (LDC) 2013 (corrected)

- 1. Returning cadets are required to participate in the JROTC Leadership Development Course (LDC) from 5 August to 15 August 2013. The course will prepare incoming cadet leadership for assumption of their duties in the new school year.
  - a. Completion of the Cadet Leadership Course (CLC) portion of LDC is required for all returning cadets.
  - b. Please complete the attached forms and return to the SAI no later than Tuesday, 4 June. There is no requirement for a Notary Public to witness the signatures; any adult can do so.
  - c. Cadets attending LDC will draw battalion t-shirts during the last week of school in preparation for LDC.
  - d. Cadets who will not be able to attend LDC must coordinate their absence from LDC with the Army Instructors prior to the start of LDC. Contact information is shown below.
- 2. Please note that LDC is one of many JROTC Summer Camp opportunities, but that *LDC* is required for returning Jaguar Battalion cadets.
- 3. LDC schedule and program. See the Training Program attached.
  - a. The Cadet Leadership Course (CLC) is the core of LDC and consists of classroom instruction and the COPE course. CLC starts with a full day field trip to the COPE course at Camp Cherokee near Athens, Texas. The course includes a Reception Day for new cadets and an optional pizza party. There is no cost for CLC but the optional pizza party on 9 August will cost approximately \$6.00 to attend and you will need about \$5.00 for fast food on COPE day. Uniform is Battalion T-shirt and long pants (jeans or khakis) for COPE and school standard dress and grooming for the classroom portions of CLC. Uniform for R-Day is Class B.
    - 1. **COPE Course.** This is a one-day field trip to the COPE Course run by the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) at Camp Cherokee. The COPE Course develops teamwork, self-confidence and trust among the new command team. It includes team-building exercises and obstacle course types of activity and is conducted in a field environment. Bring \$5 for a fast food breakfast (or a bag breakfast) on the way to Camp Cherokee. Lunch meal will be HeaterMeals.
    - 2. **Classroom Instruction**: Cadets should provide a sack breakfast and lunch for each day of training, which will start with physical training at 0700.

- 3. **Reception Day (R-Day)** is designed to welcome New Cadets into the battalion. There will be an HeaterMeal lunch on Reception Day and an optional pizza party at the end of R-Day.
- 1. There is currently no planned Field Training Exercise (FTX) as there has been in previous years. An FTX may still be conducted as determined by the new instructor staff.

### 4. Awards:

- a. A Leadership Development Course (LDC) ribbon (N-4-5) is earned for completion of CLC.
- 5. The **prerequisites** for the Leadership Development Course are:
  - a. An invitation to return to JROTC as an upperclassman for the next school year.
  - b. A desire for excellence and a determination to succeed. LDC is designed to challenge the cadet both mentally and physically. The cadet must have the mental toughness and the desire to overcome all obstacles in order to gain the most from the experience!
  - c. No physical disabilities that would preclude full participation in those parts that the cadet attend. There are no alternative activities available. If the cadet requires emergency medications such as inhalers, please ensure that the instructors are notified and that the medication is available while the cadet is at LDC.

**CLC-COPE:** The day starts at 0700 hours. We load busses for Camp Cherokee, located near Athens, Texas. Eat breakfast before coming to school. Cadets work low-course team building events in the morning, followed in the afternoon by challenging high-course events. These events build teamwork, trust and confidence in both personal and team abilities. MREs are served for lunch. An After Action Review completes the day and we return to JHHS approximately 1900 hours. Uniform: Bn T-shirt, long pants, water bottle (1 qt min), hat, sunscreen.

**CLC:** Each day starts with physical training at 0700 hours, followed by cleanup and a bag breakfast. At 0830, training starts and runs through lunch, which is a bag lunch. After lunch, CLC continues with a mix of training, administrative activity, and preparation and planning for upcoming events. Training will be complete by 1530 each day. Uniform: Standard Dress.

**R-DAY**: We invite our New Cadets enrolling in LET 1 for a day of training. Upperclassmen arrive at 0700 hours in Class B uniform and prepare to receive the New Cadets. They organize their companies, train the New Cadets and fit New Cadet uniforms. After New Cadet training is complete, LDC attendees are invited to a pizza party at Cici's Pizza (pay as you go). Uniform: Class B with awards.

FTX: There is no FTX planned for LDC 2013
