the volume and scale of the forests that waited to be cleared and, once cleared, the timbers produced were second to none. No longer did the craftsman have to work with the crooked, low quality materials that he built with in Europe. Now he had straight, clear-grained wood of staggering lengths to work with. Some of the trees that the settlers found were of such high quality that the



lowest branches were eighty feet from the ground. Timber frames were transformed in two or three generations from small buildings with high pitched roofs to massive structures that could



exceed one hundred and twenty feet in length. Immigrant craftsmen used the experience and knowledge of precision building design to create masterpieces.

Our product line has evolved over the last fifteen years and continues to evolve today.


Timeless Barn Company™ is not just about custom timber framing. Because we know vintage

The remodeled home looked like the traditional containers that held household salt, so the homes were nicknamed "saltboxes."


