To file online, or call a dispatcher... You **CAN NOT** file an online police report if:

This is an Emergency. (Please call 911)

This incident occured **OUTSIDE** the Columbus City limits.

There is suspect (s) information.

Suspect information is name and address.

You are reporting a theft offense, and the value of the stolen property is more than \$3,000.

You are reporting a theft offense, and the stolen property is a firearm (gun), license plates, a stolen motor vehicle, or hazardous material.

You are reporting Property Destruction, and the damage is valued at more than \$3,000.

There is evidence to indicate that this is a hate crime or bias relate.

There is any physical evidence connected to the crime that needs to be collected (i.e. blood, obvious finger-prints).

If you confirmed any of the above statements, you **CAN NOT** file your report online; you must call the Columbus Police Radio Room at 614-645-4545 where you will be prompted to speak with a dispatcher to make a report.


