



CONTEMPORARY ART AWARDS 2018

THE CONTEMPORARY ART AWARDS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. 'Contemporary Art Awards' is a non-acquisitive art award and a twelve month online exhibition. It is open to all mediums, which includes painting, works on paper, digital works, video, photography, sculpture, ceramics, installation and jewellery.
2. The award is open to all emerging artists who are:
 - a. Over the age of 18 years of age.
3. Contemporary Art Awards regards an emerging artist as:
 - a. Is in the early stages of pursuing a career as an artist and not regularly shown in a commercial gallery.
4. Works submitted must have been completed from 2016 and must be the original uncopied work of the artist.
5. The artist must warrant that they are the copyright owner of the artwork submitted with the entry and he or she indemnifies 'contemporary art awards' committee for any breach of infringement or copyright.
6. Two artworks can be submitted per entry. There is no limit to the number of entries an artist can submit. Although a separate entry form and application fee must accompany each entry.
7. Entries must be submitted via the online entry form or the hardcopy format provided on the site (PDF or word document). The entry form will ask for the artist's details, artwork details, and a maximum of 100 words artist statement about the work. If you are a finalist this statement may be edited for clarity.
8. All images must be a JPEG file and of the works entirety. High-resolution images are not advisable as it may take a while to load, must be less than 2 megabytes.
9. To all moving image entrants – If applying online, you must upload a 'still' to the website, and provide a Vimeo/Youtube link in the *additional information* section or if emailing, email it to admin@contemporaryartawards.com. These works should be no longer than 5mins.
10. A non-refundable administration fee of \$40 (Inc GST) per entry must be paid online by using either PayPal, (credit card facilities are available, if you are not a member of PayPal you can still use the credit card facilities) or direct deposit. Entries will not be accepted until entry fee has been received. Receipts will be issued upon request.
11. An artist may be required to provide additional information in connection with an application or work/s submitted. Failure to provide the additional information may result in rejection of the application.
12. Entries must be received by Midnight Tuesday, **28 November 2017**.
13. All works must be for sale. *Contemporary Art Awards* will retain a 20% commissions on all works sold during the six month online exhibition.
14. If during the period of the online exhibition an artist decides to withdraw a selected work for sale, the artist must pay 'Contemporary Art Awards' an amount equivalent to the commission payable.

15. The 20% commission is payable to the 'contemporary art awards' in respect of each work sold during the exhibition. The commission will be deducted from the sale price for the work prior to any payment being made to the artist.

JUDGING AND EXHIBITION CRITERIA

1. There will be two rounds of judging. In the first round of pre-selection, a pre-selection panel will review and assess all applications received and will decide which works will be exhibited online as finalists based on compliance with the entry criteria and the quality of the work/s submitted.
2. A judge/s will be appointed and will choose the winning artwork. The decision of the pre-selection panel and the Judge/s is final, no negotiation undertaken.
3. Finalists shall be notified no later than **Monday, 18 December 2017**.
4. Artists selected for the six month online exhibition will allow their names and images to be published on the website and their works to be reproduced by print and electronic media in the advertising, promotions, and exhibition catalogue for *Contemporary Art Awards*. *Contemporary Art Awards* reserves the right to reproduce the winning and both highly commended entries in subsequent publications by *Contemporary Art Awards* in relation to the Art Award.
5. The winner will receive a prize of \$3000.00 donated by the award sponsor 'Dynamic Events'. The award is non-acquisitive. The winner will be offered a 6 month mentoring program (this is optional) and a 500-word review of their art practice (in consultation with the artist)
6. Two highly commendation awards will each be given to those finalists found suitable by the judge and will receive a professional 500-word written review about their practice (in consultation with the artist).
7. The two highly commended finalists will also be offered 3 mentoring sessions - optional (see website for details).
8. All other finalists will be offered 2 mentoring sessions - optional (see website for details).
9. All selected finalists will be published in a catalogue this catalogue will be sent via mail.
10. The prize winner and recipients of the two highly commendation awards will be announced on 1st February 2017.
11. Please note: to be included in the published catalogue, selected finalists will need to email a high-resolution digital image no more than 5 megabytes by the **27th January 2018**. JPEG files should be saved with the following details as the file name: **Artist's first Name_Surname_ Title of work.jpeg**.
