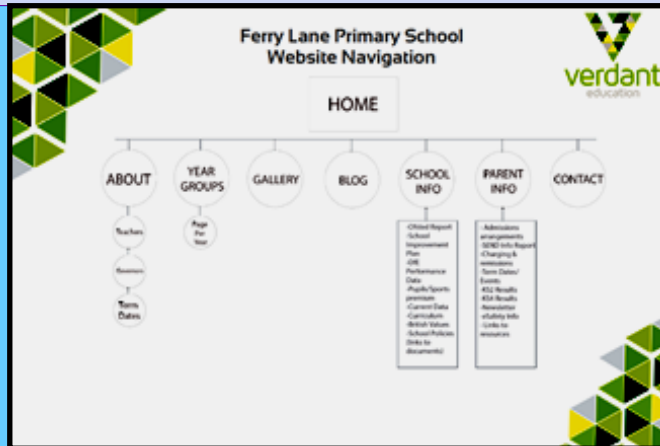




Website Photos consent for children and parents
