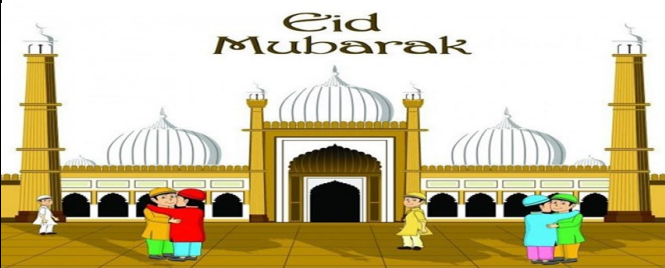
New School Logo!

Speech and Language Improvements

Our Inclusion team have helped to make great strides with children across the school who need extra help improving their speech and language skills. A programme called Language Link has had an amazing impact on these children, and now many who were identified as "severe" have moved to "moderate" or even "no further intervention required". Of those initially identified as having a "moderate" need, almost all no longer require extra help. This is a fantastic achievement and has been recognised by the local authority.

Autumn Term: First Half Term: 3rd September - 23rd October, Half Term Holiday: 26th October - 30th October, Second Half Term: 2nd November - 18th December, Christmas Holiday: 21st December - 1st January 2016.

Spring Term: First Half Term: 4th January - 12th February, Half Term Holiday: 15th February - 19th February, Second Half Term: 22nd February - 18th March, Easter Holiday: 21st March - 1st April.

Assembly Dates

Each class conducts one class assembly per term. In three weeks time the first class will hold their assembly.
