INSTRUCTIONS

APPLICATIONS: Available at www.oklahomafutesociety.org

ELIGIBILITY: Open to OFS student members in grades 9-12. Entrants must be current OFS members and registered for the Flute Fair. There is no additional entry fee for the competition. OFS will choose up to three (3) winners of this competition to perform in a master class with a guest artist at the Oklahoma Flute Fair on Saturday, April 2, 2016.

RECORDING ROUND AND MASTER CLASS PROCEDURES

1. Performers will be selected by recorded audition.
2. Repertoire should be for flute and piano or unaccompanied flute, and should be the same piece to be performed in the master class.
3. Maximum length 10 minutes. Multi-movement works are acceptable, but must be recorded as a live performance without stopping the recording between movements. Time between movements is included in the 10-minute total. The recording must not be edited in any way.
4. No cuts may be made in the flute part, however, cuts in the piano introduction/interludes are acceptable. Repeated sections marked by dot repeats or first/second endings are at the performer's discretion.
5. Accompaniment is not necessary on the application recording, but accompaniment will be used for the master class. For the class, students may perform with their own pianist, or for a fee of \$30, use the OFS collaborative pianist, Dr. Sam Magrill. If flutists choose to use the OFS Pianist, fee is due upon agreement to participate in this event and to confirm your placement in the event.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Submit an MP3 recording of the piece of your choice (as listed above), with a maximum file size of 19MB each. *No other audio format will be accepted.* Each piece, including multi-movement works, must be recorded in its entirety from beginning to end without stopping or editing. Recordings must not be edited in any way. Edited recordings will be disqualified.
2. Label the file with your LAST-FIRST name. Recordings are coded for anonymity before judging.
