Project Description

Writing is a time-honored response to powerful life experiences. In this project, the writing of military men and women about their experiences of war in all of its facets provides the inspiration for local visual artists, who will make works in response to their words. These collaborations will result in creative, paired presentations which will be on display at the Beatnik Listening Lounge May 23 - June 6, 2015. A special event co-hosted by Mil-Tree and Radio Free JT will be held on Saturday May 23rd, 2015 to present the work, featuring live readings and performances by contributors. The installation of the works will be on Thursday May 21, 2015.

“The Art of War” is a project of Mil-Tree and its purpose is twofold: to give recognition to military poets and writers, and to use the power of words and images to educate the public about their experience.
