

Alumnae Panhellenic Association of Washington, DC 2017 Scholarship Application

The Alumnae Panhellenic Association of Washington, DC will award scholarships for the 2017-2018 academic year to qualified applicants. This past year, the Association awarded two scholarships of \$1200 each. We hope to award at least the same amount of money this year, and reserve the right to determine how many scholarships will be awarded and in what amount.

The applicant eligibility criteria are as follows: (1) Member in good standing of a fully participating sorority of the National Panhellenic Conference; (2) Rising sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student in fall 2017; and (3) From the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area or attending school in the Washington, DC metropolitan area. Applications must be received by March 31, 2017 and no late applications will be considered.

Scholarship recipients will be chosen at the Association's discretion, based on a combination of scholarship merit and the quality of the application, short essay and recommendation. Incomplete applications or those not in compliance with the instructions provided may be discarded at the Association's discretion. Recipients will be notified by April 15, 2017.
