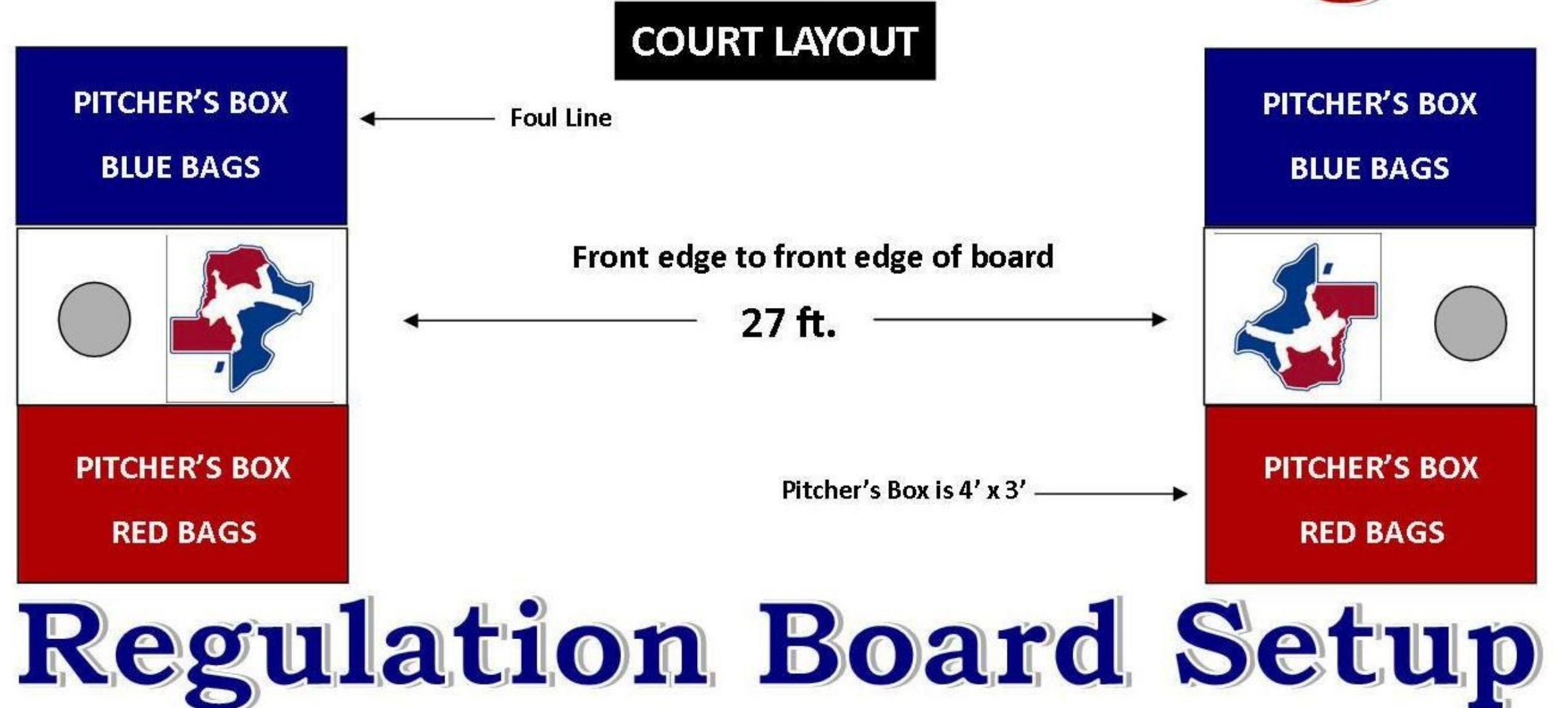


Cornhole Rules

Texas Cornhole League



The Cornhole Bags:

1. There should be 8 bags, 4 bags of each color.
2. Each bag should be 6 inches by 6 inches and have 1 pound of corn / resin inserted into each cornhole

Coin Toss:

Singles Play - A coin flip will determine choice of side **OR** 1st bag honors

Doubles Play - A coin flip will determine choice of side and 1st bag honors **OR** match up between players

*Match up Option: Other team will choose side and then walk to their spots. Then you choose match up

*Playing Best 2/3. Loser of Game 1 Coin Toss will choose in the 2nd Game. If a Game 3 Flip a Coin

*In Game 2 you do not have to switch sides or ends it is up to team that lost coin toss in Game 1 to choose.

*Color of Bags thrown determined by scoreboard color of side chosen

Cornhole Game Play:

1. Partners shall stand at opposite cornhole boxes on the same side, from the perspective of a third person, and face each other, so there is no advantage given to one team.
2. Alternate throws between the two opponent players until all 8 cornhole bags have been thrown.
3. If a bag hits the ground then bounces up onto the board, that bag shall be taken off the playing surface.
4. The team who scores is given honors to throw first in the next round.
5. If both teams have the same score. Team that scored last goes first
6. Game continues until one team reaches **21 or more points**.

Raking Cornhole Bags: If Bags become piled inside the cornhole board hole and may interfere or obstruct with the next pitch or if there is a question whether a bag would have naturally fallen through the hole, a player may request to “rake” the cornhole bags that have fallen inside the hole. Important Note: All efforts should be made to leave bags on playing surface undisturbed.

Scoring:

1. The score shall be taken after all cornhole bags have been thrown for a round.
2. Points shall be given as follows.
 - . A. **3 points** for a cornhole bag that goes through the hole. Considered a **Cornhole YALL**
 - . B. 1 point for a cornhole bag that is on the playing surface.
 - . C. 1 point for a cornhole bag that is hanging into the hole.
 - . D. 1 point for a cornhole bag that is hanging off the edge but not touching the ground.
 - . E. 0 points for a cornhole bag that is on the playing surface, but also touching the ground.
 - . F. 0 points for a cornhole bag that is hanging off the front edge and is resting on a cornhole bag that is on the ground (unless the cornhole bag on the ground can be removed without making the hanging bag fall to the ground, then one point is given).

**All 4 in is a
BIG TEX**

Fouls: A foul occurs when any of the following happens

1. A cornhole players foot goes past the foot foul line, termed a foot foul.
2. A player goes out of turn.

The player who caused the foul loses the throw when the foul occurred and the bag shall be removed if it landed on the playing surface.
