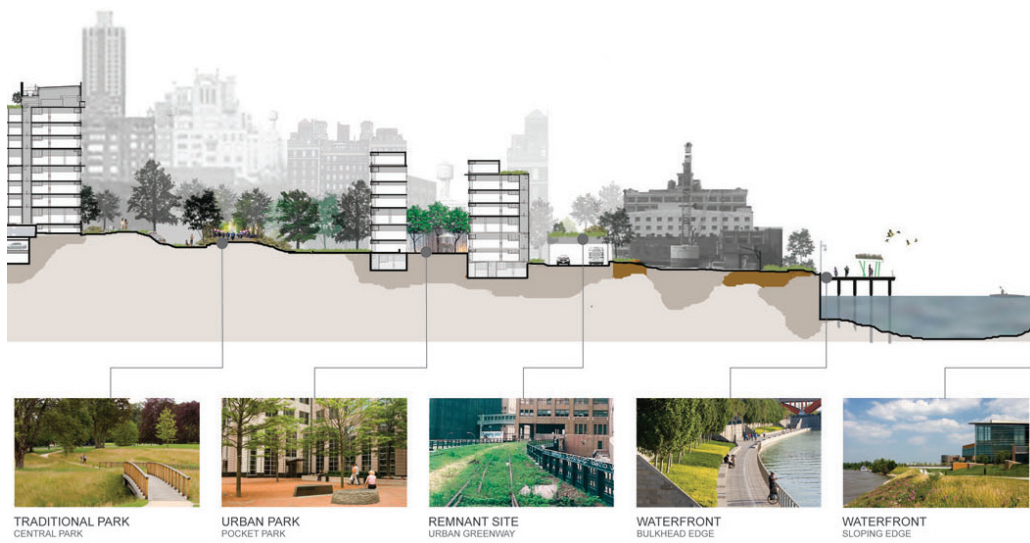
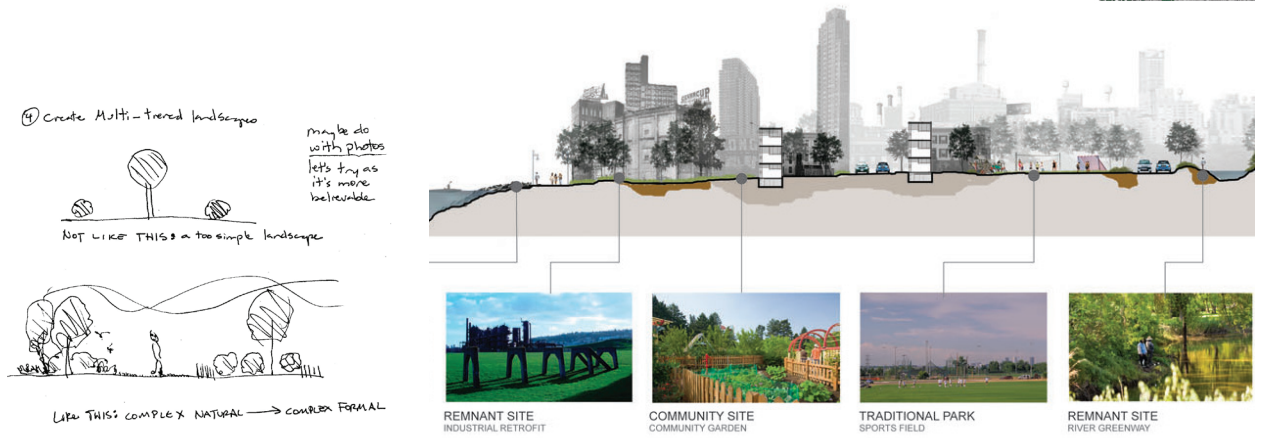


Sustainable Park Design for the 21st Century Design Trust for Public Space

New York, New York, 2008-2009



As a fellow for the Design Trust for Public Space, Tavis Dockwiler of Viridian Landscape Studio was a primary author of the New York City Department of Parks and Recreation sustainable guidelines for the city's 29,000 acres of Parkland. Park Design for the 21st Century culminated in the publication of the High Performance Landscape Guidelines - the third in the trilogy of sustainable design manuals. The Design Trust's previous publications, High Performance Building Guidelines (1999) and High Performance Infrastructure Guidelines (2005) set the stage for a paradigm shift in the way New York City is constructed. High Performance Landscape Guidelines sets new standards for sustainability in public parks of NYC.
