



How To Qualify For The 2014 Southeast Medal Finals

Equitation Finals

2014 Phelps Media Group Southeast Junior Medal Finals

Open to riders that have won first, second or third in any medal or equitation class where the jumps are 3' or higher between September 23, 2013 and September 14, 2014. Riders may also qualify by winning a ribbon in class 400 & 401 Phelps Media Group Wild Card Class at the 2014 Southeast Medal Finals.

2014 Southeast Adult Medal Finals

Open to riders that have won first, second or third in any medal or equitation class where the jumps are 3' or higher between September 23, 2013 and September 14, 2014. Riders may also qualify by winning a ribbon in class 405 & 406 Phelps Media Group Wild Card Class at the 2014 Southeast Medal Finals.

Southeast 2'6" Children's/Adult Medal Finals

Open to riders that have won a 1 thru 6th place at a SEMF sanctioned show or in any equitation class that requires horses to jump 2'6" between September 23, 2013 and September 14, 2014. Riders may also qualify by winning a ribbon in class 428 or 429 at the 2014 Southeast Medal Finals.

Hunter Finals

Southeast Children's Hunter Horse Finals

Open to horses and riders that have been champion or reserve champion in a 3' Adult Hunter Division between the dates of September 23, 2013 and September 14, 2014 at a USEF recognized or unrecognized horse show. A horse and rider combination may also qualify at the Southeast Medal Finals 2014 by winning a 1 thru 8th place ribbon in Children's Hunter Divisions at this show. Riders are not limited to the number of horses ridden.

This class will NOT count towards USEF or USHJA HOY or Zone awards.

Southeast Adult Amateur Hunter Finals

Open to horses and riders that have been champion or reserve champion in a 3' Adult Hunter Division between the dates of September 23, 2013 and September 14, 2014 at a USEF recognized or unrecognized horse show. A horse and rider combination may also qualify at the Southeast Medal Finals 2014 by winning a 1 thru 8th place ribbon in Adult Amateur Hunter Divisions at this show. Riders are not limited to the number of horses ridden.

This class will NOT count towards USEF or USHJA HOY or Zone awards.

Southeast 2'6" Children's/Adult Hunter Finals

Open to horses and riders that have been champion or reserve champion in a 2'6" Children's or Adult Hunter Division between the dates of September 23, 2013 and September 14, 2014 at a USEF recognized or unrecognized horse show. A horse and rider combination may also qualify at the Southeast Medal Finals 2014 by winning a 1 thru 8th place ribbon in 2'6" Adult Hunter or 2'6" Children's Hunter Divisions at this show. Riders are not limited to the number of horses ridden.

This class will NOT count towards USEF or USHJA HOY or Zone awards.
