

Parents/Carers Meetings with Class Teachers



At St Werburgh's Primary School the school operates an open door policy to discuss any matters relating to school life. Parents/carers are welcome to contact the Headteacher, their child's teacher or the Learning Mentor at any time to discuss any issues or concerns they have about their child.

Parents/carers will also have the opportunity to meet formally with their child's teacher three times a year as well as a written report at the end of the school year:

September **An Introductory meeting** to enable parents to learn about the class organisation

October **Individual appointments** with your child's teacher

March **Individual appointments** with your child's teacher

July **Written report** may be discussed with the teacher.

Open Afternoons – parents/carers will also be invited into school during the day to view their children's work in their child's class alongside other parents and children.

The school has a Learning Mentor and she will meet with all new parents and also any parent who needs to discuss family issues.

Should the school have any concern about your child's progress you will be contacted.

Written Report

A written report outlining your child's progress over the academic year is provided towards the end of the year.

Summer Meetings - New Parents and Children

All parents/carers are warmly invited to a meeting at school in the Summer Term prior to their child starting. This will be an opportunity to meet some of the staff and be shown around the school. At this time children and parents are also invited to come to school to visit their classroom and meet their teacher.
