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Kootenay road trip Highway 93S

It once took a whole day in a Model T Ford to drive from Banff to Radium Hot Springs when Kootenay National Park's road opened for touring and transporting goods. Today, make the return trip in a day and stop to enjoy these terrific places:



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- 1 Stand on the **Continental Divide**—the point from which water flows to two different oceans. Stroll the 0.5-km **Fireweed Trail** and discover how fire renews forests.
- 2 Energetic? Hike the amazing trail of fire and ice to **Stanley Glacier** (3 hours/8.4 km round trip).
- 3 View **Marble Canyon's** deep carved chasms and gorgeous turquoise waters from seven different bridges.
- 4 Stop at **Numa Falls** for a picnic or snack break.
- 5 Keep your binoculars ready! Along this route you may see deer, bears, goats, wolves and bighorn sheep.
- 6 Admire breathtaking views of the Mitchell and Vermilion ranges from the **Kootenay Valley Viewpoint**.
- 7 Look up at the towering red cliffs of the **Redwall Fault** in Sinclair Canyon.
- 8 Get out your swim suits and relax in the **Radium Hot Springs** pools before you check out the village and return to Banff.
