Event Highlights

Festival Opening Party

With its award-winning streetscape and densely populated bars and restaurants, Leigh Street will be the destination to celebrate the opening of the 2015 Festival of Architecture and Design in Adelaide. Precarious Life/Work

Guildhouse will convene a conversation about risk taking as a method of practice in art, architecture and design. Join guests James Dodd (artist) and Damien Chwalisz (architect) in conversation with Teri Hoskin (writer designer curator) about precarious living, labor, life, and the rich possibilities of exchange between the spatial awareness of artists/designers and architects.

The Hero Shot exhibition
