Rides

- We are planning two groups rides. Both will be ridden on both Tuesday and Thursday. Wednesday will be a rain date. You will be able to do both group rides, one on each day, while we can keep the size of each group a bit smaller. Details on these rides will be provided next spring, once we've had a chance to pre-ride the routes and check for construction, winter road damage, etc.
- We are also planning to put together several self-guided rides, which
 you may decide to do instead of the group rides, or on Wednesday.

About Lake George

Copied from Wikipedia: Lake George, nicknamed the Queen of American Lakes, [2] is a long, narrow oligotrophic lake located at the southeast base of the Adirondack Mountains, in the northeastern portion of the U.S. state of New York. It lies within the upper region of the Great Appalachian Valley and drains northward into Lake Champlain and the St. Lawrence River drainage basin. The lake is situated along the historical natural (Amerindian) path between the valley of the Hudson River and that of the St. Lawrence, so lies on the direct land route between Albany, New York and Montreal, Canada. The lake extends about 32.2 mi (51.8 km) on a north-south axis, is quite deep, and varies from 1 to 3 miles (1.7 to 5 km) in width, presenting a significant barrier to east-west travel. Although the year-round population of the Lake George region is relatively small, the summertime population can swell to over 50,000 residents, many in the Village of Lake George region at the southern end of the lake.

Lodging and Reservations

- Reservations (VBA Rally)
 - We have 50 rooms blocked (single or double occupancy) until June 23, 2017
 - 45 Rooms (double queen) at \$89.99 / night (before taxes)
 - 5 Rooms (single king) at \$95.99 / night (before taxes)
 - Note that the motel is closed now for the winter until May 31st.
 - 518-668-4141 (Hotel Front Desk). Identify yourself as a member of the VBA Rally. Note that the best times to call the motel are between 9 AM and 5 PM eastern. If no one answers the phone, leave a message. Someone will get back to you within about 24 hours.
 - Cancellations: Must cancel no later than 15 days before arrival to avoid a cancellation charge of one night's stay.
