### **2011 Junior Camp Rules**

## IMPORTANT! The 2011 Jr. Camp application, rules, and Liability Release forms are to be signed and returned together.

- 1. No registered camper will be permitted to leave the campgrounds at any time, with or without the parents, unless the Junior Camp Director has granted previous permission.
- 2. Only those campers who have registered will be permitted to attend any Junior Camp classes. All registered campers are expected to attend all the classes at the prescribed times.
- 3. No camper should ever leave their dorm or room at night for any reason without their counselor's knowledge.
- 4. Do not exchange dorm space without the approval from the Junior Camp Staff.
- 5. Don't leave electrical appliances on when not in your room.
- 6. Do not leave valuables in the dorm.
- 7. Girls dorms are off limits to boys, as well as boys dorms are off limits to girls.
- 8. "Lights out" will be ½ hour after curfew.
- 9. Any food received from the canteen will be paid for above and beyond the registration fee.
- 10. Each camper will be expected to respect the Junior Camp Staff at all times.
- 11. All campers are expected to wear proper clothing as prescribed by the CT. District UPCI.
  - A. Boys; shall be required to wear a shirt and long trousers at all times (except in the dorm).
  - B. Girls; shall be required to wear a dress or blouse and skirt of proper length, below the knees at all times.
  - C. Jewelry, sleeveless tops, high heeled or "platform" shoes, slits above the knee and makeup are prohibited.
- 12. It is not permitted to wear sweat pants in the canteen.
- 13. There will be no physical contact between girls and boys, including holding hands.
- 14. No squirt guns, CD players, radios, walkmans, or any electrical/portable musical source.
- 15. Attendance at night service is required. Children not registered in Junior Camp will only be permitted in the night service if they are accompanied by an adult who will be responsible for them throughout the service.
- 16. After service dismissal, campers must remain in the canteen area until escorted by camp staff to their dorm.
- 17. The right is reserved to formulate any rule or regulation deemed necessary.

If for some reason the above rules are not observed, those campers who violate such may be asked to terminate their stay on the campgrounds. The Supervisory Committee will determine such action.

### Jr. Camper Details

### Dear Parent and Camper,

To make the Jr Camp Experience more complete, safe and enjoyable, consider these details:

### The Camper will need

- Bible
- Towels, washcloths, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- Swimwear (with an extra towel) if you plan to swim.
- Clean and neat (but casual) clothes for 5 church services
- Play clothes for 5 day sessions with activities.
- Bedding, twin size top and bottom sheet with a light blanket or sleeping bag and pillow.
- If you have spending money, please have your parents put the daily allotted amount in an envelope with your name and day to be used noted on the front. These will be turned in at registration and held in the office until the counselors distribute them at the first snack time of the appropriate day.

#### **Medications**

- Parents of campers needing medications during the week need to bring prescription bottles with campers name and instructions of use to registration.
- The bottles should only have to needed amount of medication for the week of camp. Prescription bottles will be placed in a Ziploc bag with the campers name on bag.
- The camp nurse will be present at registration to collect medications and meet the camper. The camp nurse will also be available for questions or medical concerns pertinent to camper and camp.
- Parents and nurse will decide who should dispense medications (counselor, nurse, or camper). Only responsible senior campers will be allowed to dispense and keep medications with them.
- The medications will be kept in a locked box with the nurse unless the medications are being given by counselor or camper. Counselors who will be administering certain medications (inhalers) will be responsible to keep medications in a safe place as well as administering medications to camper as directed.
- The camp nurse will supply counselor with a record to keep track of which medications to give to who and when. Campers in possession of their own medications are responsible to make sure they are placed in a safe place and taken at the appropriate times.
