Meeting and Itinerary

Participants will meet at the venue's function room, at 11:45am on the 29th April 2017. It is your responsibility to be in time for this initial drivers' meeting. You can book into the venue either Friday night or the Saturday morning (see below for booking info).

- 12 noon – lunch at cafe
- 12:30 pm – final driver session
- 2pm – return to camp

Equipment

Participants should bring the following equipment, or contact us to arrange a loan item:

- snatch strap (min 10000 kg)
- 2 rated shackles
- UHF radio
- air-down (deflation) tool (ARB, Staun)
- air compressor (preferably min of 75 l/min) and tyre pressure gauge
- gloves
- drinking water
- Clothing suitable for any possible weather conditions, rain jacket, solid shoes, a hat

We will provide other recovery, diagnostic and repair equipment when required.
