Facilitated Play Sessions

Better Than the Dog Park!

- There is no way to verify dogs at the park are healthy, or have ever been vaccinated.
- The ground can hold parasites and various diseases. Parvo is there, and it stays for years.
- Dog parks can be sandy, dusty, or muddy and dogs get filthy.
- Dogs at parks risk learning inappropriate play, getting bullied, and serious injury from other dogs.
- ***In Facilitated Play, dogs are screened for health, vaccination and temperament and the play space is sanitized between sessions.***

Better Than Doggie Daycare!

- Daycares rarely have an adequate number of people with the dogs, leaving all dogs at risk.
- Many are overcrowded with dogs, leaving many to be being bullied, develop bad behaviors, or injured.
- Few daycares have staff that have been formally or adequately educated in dog training and behavior.
- Many behavior problems are not humanely or effectively addressed by staff.
- Dogs frequently come to be after developing problem behaviors at daycare, such as urinating in the house, excessive barking, fear of or aggression toward other dogs, general rudeness, and more.
- ***All Facilitated Play sessions are limited to six dogs, play is moderated to remain appropriate, unwanted behaviors are effectively addressed, and dogs learn new skills.***

About Facilitated Play

- Dogs must be at least 9 mos old, spayed or neutered, and vaccinated
- All dogs receive a free assessment for compatibility
- Owners remain in session with their dog unless otherwise agreed upon
- Groups are limited to 6 dogs on a first-come, first-serve basis with a reservation option available
