

West Career Academy APEX Policy

Many of our classes at West Career Academy utilize an online program called APEX. While taking classes using this online program, students will follow these guidelines.

- > Students in a study hall are accountable to their teacher for attendance and progress
- ➤ All students using APEX MUST BE monitored by a teacher throughout the entire duration of the test, and all tests must remain with teachers. Any test that leaves the presence of a teacher must be redone.
- ➤ Students should not be on ANY internet site while taking a computer test (CST)
- ➤ Students may not use phones or tablets during computer tests, EXCEPT for music
- Any violation of these rules will result in a student retaking the computer test on paper, using the entire question bank of 60-75 questions
- ➤ If a student cheats on a test, he or she will receive a zero for that test.
- Repeat offenses will be handled on a case by case basis, but could result in expulsion.


West Career Academy Attendance Policy

Our main goal at WCA is to get you ready to enter a career or college with the skills necessary to be successful. In any job, missed work means you might get fired. Just like an employer, at our school we have to know that we can rely on you to be self-motivated and here at school every day.

- > You must maintain an 80% attendance rate. Attendance will be reviewed every two weeks.
- ➤ If you miss a class, you must see that teacher during office hours or advisement to get caught up.
- ➤ Failure to achieve 80% or higher attendance each week and failure to remain on track in your classes may result in you being dropped from individual classes, having your schedule changed, or being placed on an attendance contract.
- ➤ If schedule changes and attendance contracts do not improve your attendance, you may be dropped from the program.
- > Students who are dropped from the program will need to reapply and plead their case to the student council before being re-enrolled.
- > Students who achieve a 90% or higher attendance rate each month will receive a free bus pass.
- Tardiness is discouraged, but if you arrive late, you must sign-in at the office and get a pass to class from Ira or another office staff member.
- All absences will be counted as unexcused UNLESS a parent or guardian calls ahead or if you provide a doctor/court/parent/guardian note upon your return. Decisions about excused absences will be made on a case by case basis.
