3 **Add your Average National Finish (1) to your Average Regional Finish (2) for your Total Points Rating**

Why Change the National Championship?

We launched our .25 Program in 2009 with 6 Clubs, and have grown each year to nearly 40 clubs in 2016! The National Championship has evolved from a 8 event series in 2009 over 6 tracks centered in the midwest to last year taking your best 4 events out of 13 races throughout the U.S.! We have been working nearly two years on a system that recognizes top Champions yet limits the demands of time and cost it was taking to travel throughout the country for a youth Championship.

There are 22 race weekends between May and September, the heart of quarter midget racing season. As we grow with added regions and tracks, the demand for local club regional and special event races has increased dramatically in the past few years, Growing our traditional National Calendar of 12-15 events takes away from local and regional racing and often forces parents to choose to be “National” or “Regional” racers. We want a system that allows all families the opportunity to focus on both throughout the racing season.

Why Use Averages?

National Race Averages are kept separate from Regional Race Averages to allow competitors to race the minimum of National Events (2 for Pavement, 1 for Dirt) or more to the maximum of 4 National Events in 2016.

Why No Throw Out Races?

Allowing “best number of races” and throwing out poor performances creates the ability for those who have the luxury of time and resources to enhance their performance simply by increasing their number of racing opportunities, and does not necessarily recognize top performance when all factors are considered.

My Region Has A Higher (or lower) Car Count Than Other Regions

Throughout 2015 we analyzed regional difference in car count, and surprisingly to many the car count variations were normally within a 2 car range on average for all regions, all classes. In the new points system, car counts are used as a event bonus up to a limit of 10 for Regional races and 20 for National races. These limits offset fluctuations in car counts, up to a limit.
