IMPORTANT

Participants must be residents of the State of South Dakota. Only one entry per child is allowed. Each poster must be colored by the child with no outside assistance. A Smokey Bear plush toy will be awarded to the contest winners in each category on or before May 31, 2016. Posters will not be returned. Paint, markers, crayons, or colored pencils are mediums that may be used.

- **Offered for Ages 3-7:** Contestants submit the official "High Five" picture.
- **Offered for Ages 8-12:** Contestants submit the official "Home Sweet Home" picture.
