## SNIPER TRAINER COURSE



In association with Advanced Combat Evolutions

**Course Description:** This 40 hour course focuses on instructor and sniper program development. Students will get extensive experience honing their instruction skills throughout the course while building shooting drills, courses of fire, and training philosophies. This is a learn-by-doing course that demands a high level of student participation. Prior sniper training and experience is required to attend this course. Students must have a firm grasp on the fundamentals of law enforcement sniping prior to their attendance, as this is a fast-moving advanced course that focuses on teaching basics and fundamentals as opposed to learning them. Students will learn how to design and implement a training matrix, create and teach training blocks, document training, and design courses of fire.

**Prerequisite:** Students must be a full-time sworn law enforcement officer assigned to a Special Weapons and Tactics team, and have passed a POST-certified Basic Sniper Course or approved equivalent.

- Equipment:** Precision scoped rifle caliber .308 or higher (no .50 BMG) capable of shooting 1 MOA or better, 500 rounds of factory ammunition, any assigned specialty ammunition (barrier rounds, etc), all assigned tactical gear including a flashlight and backpack, eye & ear protection, rifle cleaning materials, manual for scope, and rifle data book.
- Attire:** The dress for this class is relaxed due to the instruction requirements. It is recommended that the students attend in BDU's or their department's deployment uniform.
