Enjoy baijiu in one of two ways...

Traditional: Straight

The traditional Chinese way. Baijiu has a full-bodied, rich flavor so savour its complexity. Raise your glasses for a toast and 'clink' in the lowest position to demonstrate humility. Then shout 'gan bei', which means 'dry the glass' and show your empty glass to prove just that! Repeat as required to celebrate!

Contemporary: Straight

We have worked hard to develop a range of unique, artisan baijiu-based cocktails. Our drinks are designed to work with the unmistakable flavours of baijiu to introduce you to the unique taste of the spirit. We also infuse baijiu with a wide variety of ingredients to bring a fresh twist to this oriental alcohol.

Du Kang (42%) | 2.50

Bouquet: Peppery, ripe peach and toasted rice

Palate: Slight sweetness, peach and pear

- Named after the legend of 'Du Kang':
the inventor of Chinese liquor

Er Guo Tou (Red Star) (56%) | 2.50

Bouquet: Light and mild

Palate: Sweet pomelo and a long finish

- The most popular drink in Northern China
- Known as "The Drink for the People"

HKB (Hong Kong Baijiu) (43%) | 4.00

Bouquet: Red fruits, green apple, and sweet meadow grasses

Palate: Sweet, subtle flavours of fruit; long, fragrant finish

- Produced in small batches in Sichuan province
- A sipping baijiu designed to appeal to Western palates

Luzhou Laojiao (52%) | 4.00

Bouquet: Peppery, ripe peach, toasted rice

Palate: Slight sweetness, peach and pear

- Established in 1573
- One of the oldest distilleries in China

Moutai (53%) | 15.00

Bouquet: Floral, dried dates with a hint of nuts and toasted rice

Palate: Silky, spicy, dry but smooth

- Originated during the Qing Dynasty
- The leading luxury baijiu brand in China

Forge Mill, Chenin Blanc, SA | 4.00 / 15.00

An abundance of guava / gooseberries on the nose, the palate follows through with fresh fruit flavours, balanced by a crisp acidity for a fresh and fruity wine

De Waal, Sauvignon Blanc, SA | 4.85 / 19.50

Medium bodied with a typical grassy character, the taste of this dry sauvignon is well concentrated with light citrus notes and a pleasing taste of fresh fruit

Jealous Sisters, Pinot Grigio, NZ | 6.50 / 24.00

Beautiful aroma of pear and apricot, but finishing quite nutty on the nose.

Complex ripe fruit on the palate, ending with a hint of spice

Pagos de Aria, Tempranillo, Cab Sauv, SP | 4.80 / 18.50

Aromatic nose of blackberry, raspberry and plums with a toasty character.

Complex palate with a fairly high but balanced acidity

Arido, Malbec, AR | 5.50 / 21.50

Bright and fresh with blackcurrant and blackberry aromas.

Plump and soft on the palate with cassis and coffee flavours and refreshing acidity

Tres al Cuadrado, Merlot, Temp, SP | 6.80 / 26.50

A light and easy drinking wine with a large amount of red fruit notes

and some balsamic and spicy nuances

ROSÉ

Anjou Pierre Brevin, Cab Franc, Grolleau, FR | 5.50 / 21.00

A fairly dry yet juicy wine with a rich blush, this has a full and complex body

which balances harmoniously with the juicy sweetness of rhubarb

FIZZ 125ml/bottle

Prosecco, Spumante, IT | 4.80 / 18.50

Fully sparkling wine, light and harmonious, well balanced taste with a soft, smooth acidity.

White fruit notes of ripe apple, pear and hints of almond on the palate
