Refund Policy

1. A full refund is granted on any program cancelled by the Summit Park District due to insufficient program registration.
2. No refunds will be granted after the start of a program except for medical excuse or relocation out of the area. A Doctor's note is required when requesting the refund. All refunds will be pro-rated from the time of the request and an administrative fee charged.
3. A \$5.00 Administrative Fee will be charged to all refund requests.
4. No refunds are allowed for leagues, trips or tournaments unless a replacement is found to fill the spot.
5. All refund requests must be made in writing at Summit Park District located at 5700 S. Archer Road. Refund request forms are available at the Front Desk of SPARK Recreation Center.
6. Participants removed from a program due to behavior or safety issues will not be granted a refund.
7. **Memberships are Non-Refundable and Non-Transferable.**

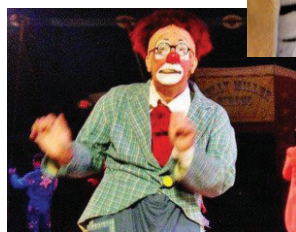

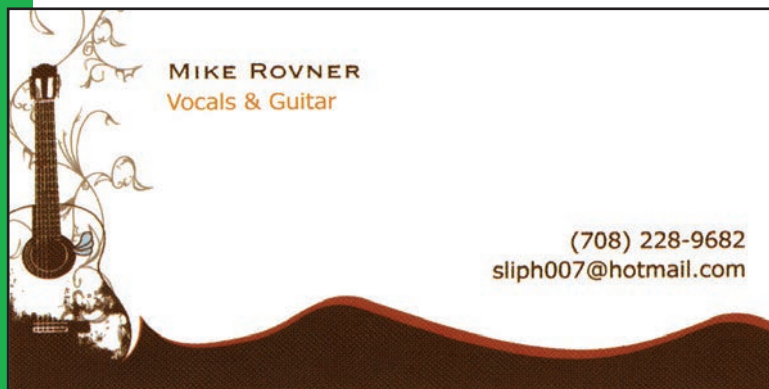
