The Court – Access – Page. 12

Says:

Access to the court is lateral and symmetric with the centre There may be 1 or 2 on each side, with or without a door (see rule 16 Authorised out of court play).

In the case of a court which does not have doors in the access space but has a metal or similar structural reinforcement with a bar on the ground at the bottom of the gap it is understood to be part of the same structure for all statutory purposes. In the event that no such bar exists the vertical part of this space is considered ‘inside the court’ independent of whether it has a line painted on it or not.

Rule 1. Score in a game – Alternative scoring methods – Marking a game.

second point -	“30”

Rule 6. The Service.

This rule should include a court plan with the service and service reception boxes highlighted.

Rule 17. Change of balls.
