There was an Official Nomination form that must be used. (on www.BCANY.org)

Original nomination could have been made by:

- 1. Varsity Basketball Coach at a New York State High School.
- 2. Recognized New York sportswriter or sports media person.
- 3. The deadline for nominations was the end of the day January 31, 2017.

A committee appointed by the leadership of BCANY reviewed the nominations and verified the information about the finalists,

The final selection of Mr. and Miss New York Basketball will be a combination of two processes:

- A. Current coaches who are BCANY members may each vote once using a 3 points for 1st choice, 2 points for second choice and 1 point for third choice. The vote will be conducted electronically. Information on the finalists will be posted on www.BCANY.org and will be contained in an email blast to all BCANY members. (counts for 49% of total)
- B. A Mr. New York Basketball selection committee and a Miss New York Basketball selection committee appointed by the BCANY Executive Committee will make the final decision after all voting by the BCANY membership is completed. (counts for 51% of total)

BCANY Members will receive an email ballot in Mid-February and all ballots must be cast by February 23, 2017
