Whites

- Riesling: Dr. Konstantin Frank**, Finger Lakes, NY; 2015 ...44
An expressive wine with notes of orange blossom, lavender, pear and honey. The vibrant mouth feel of this wine reveals flavors of apple, peach, mandarin oranges and leads into a zesty fruit finish.
- Sauvignon Blanc: Bliss Family Vineyards**, Mendocino, CA; 2015 ...34
Green apple and tangerine scents waft from the glass. Soft grapefruit and sweet pineapple come with an acidity that is smooth and seamless on the palate. Stainless steel fermented allows this wine to finish bright and citrusy.
- Chardonnay: Bluewing Vineyards**, Sonoma Coast, CA; 2012 ...32
A Rodney Strong project that was aged partially in stainless steel and finished in oak. Vanilla-laced lemon meringue on the nose sets up flavors of Gala apple and lime blossom with a creamy texture, finishing with a pulsing acidity.

Rosé

- Sangiovese: Barnard Griffin**, Columbia Valley, WA; 2015 ...38
Winemaker Rob Griffin has won gold at the San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition for almost a decade with this native Tuscan grape. Aged in stainless steel to preserve freshness, it begins with hints of melon and citrus, laced with pomegranate and cranberry with a vividly acidic finish.

Reds

- Syrah: McManis Family Vineyard**, CA; 2014 ...36
Medium in body, but full in flavor. Aromas of scorched earth, ripe blackberry and cassis pave the way for a decadent mouthfeel with raspberry, cherry, and hints of toffee.
- Cabernet Sauvignon: Vina Robles**, Paso Robles, CA; 2013 ...54
A Central Coast delight starts off with tobacco and a hint of cinnamon on the nose, chewy tannins extract red currant, blackberry and finishes with toasted oak.
- Blend: Three, Old Vines Field Blend**, Contra Costa County, CA; 2013 ... 48
From 90-150 year old vines, Zinfandel, Carignan, Petite Sirah, Mouvedre, and Alicante Bouschet meld together into a work of liquid art. Deep purple tones open up to aromas of smoky blackberry and violets, cherry liqueur and boysenberry light up the palate, ending with vibrant raspberry and a kiss of mocha.

Whites

- Sauvignon Blanc: Trione**, Russian River Valley, Sonoma County, CA; 2015 ... 52
Coming from the heart of this AVA in River Road Ranch, this hand-picked fruit is perfectly structured to bring out a unique take on this grape. A floral bouquet with melon and honey notes open up to flavors of white grapefruit and a stunning minerality. 90 points from Wine Enthusiast.
- Chardonnay: Benziger Family**, Sonoma Coast, CA; 2013 ...56
Soft citrus and apricot on the nose pave the way for a bright medley of apple and pear flavors. A slightly creamy texture rounds out the palate ending with a hint of lemon zest.
- Viognier: Michael Shaps**, Mountain View Vineyard, Monticello, VA; 2015 ... 65
100% stainless. Lifted aromas of jasmine, apricot and guava emanate from the glass, with layered flavors of citrus, stone and tropical fruits. One of the finest examples of this Virginia-grown varietal.

Rosé

- Grenache: Elizabeth Spencer**, Mendocino County, CA; 2015 ...42
100% Grenache from a vineyard owned by the family since 1918. Electric pink with aromas of strawberry and guava. Exhibits quince notes and sweet cherry and white peach. Not overly dry, with a somewhat creamy texture and perfectly balanced finish.

Reds

- Pinot Noir: Russian Hill**, Russian River Valley, Sonoma, CA; 2009 ...82
Dazzling ruby color, fragrant notes of white pepper and pomegranate with deep herbal undertones. Traces of toasted oak leave you with a silky soft finish of the most refined tannins. A brilliant year for CA!
- Merlot: Robert Hall**, Paso Robles, CA; 2013 ... 58
A gold medal winner in the Central Coast wine competition, this gem does not disappoint. Concentrated black cherry with hints of licorice on the nose open up to luscious layers of blueberry and cedar, with a decadent silky finish.
- Zinfandel: Lake Sonoma**, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County, CA; 2012 ... 64
Classic, jammy, fruit-forward, and complex, this wine provides a full symphony of flavors including blackberry, boysenberry, cherry and raspberry with a drop of spice and toasted oak. A fabulous selection.
