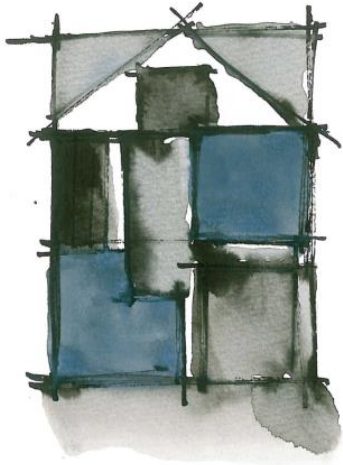


Deux Punx

Cabernet Franc “Alibini Vineyard”



Deux Punx was founded by Dan Schaaf and Aaron Olson, two wine addicted ex-punks, in April of 2008. All of their wines are produced in the same manner – native fermentation, minimal so₂, neutral oak, and ambient temperatures. Deux Punx believes wine is meant to be shared and enjoyed, not cellared and ignored. So go buy a bottle and drink it!

From the winemakers: “Second efforts for the Punx with Cab Franc. So many things you can do with this grape; we went light and easy! The winemaking approach was incredibly simple using only ambient temperatures and native fermentation. No acid adds and no enzymes. And just a few short months in neutral French oak. The acids are soft and stay in your mouth for days. Plenty of pepper going on here and it’s balanced perfectly with sausage spices, dark fruit and earth. Mouthwatering! “

Vinification Harvested September 19th. Fermented for 14 days, native yeast with 20% whole cluster grapes. Aged for a few months in neutral barrels. Unfined and unfiltered. Bottled in the February following harvest.

Tasting Notes Classic Cabernet Franc with aromas of bell pepper, tomato, and earthiness echoed on the palate with hints of red fruit as well. Pairs well with a wide variety of foods, including charcuterie, burgers, and portobello caps.



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
