



# THE REMOTE CONTROLLER

## Remote Controller (the “Programme”) – Terms and Conditions

- You must submit a written proposal for your television show of not more than 500 words, together with your name and contact details. As ideas are not protected by copyright, your written proposal should give a reasonably detailed outline of your television show for your own benefit and protection.
- All written proposals must be inputted into the PROPOSAL text box on the submission page before midnight on 28/02/2017 (“Closing Date”). We will not accept any other method of delivery. Any proposals received by NIT after the Closing Date may not be considered for the Programme. Any proposals submitted by any other means than the PROPOSAL text box on the submission page, will not be accepted.
- You must be 18 years or older.
- You must not have worked in the television or film industry, or work/have worked for NIT Television or any affiliate, or any UK broadcaster, or be a live-in partner or immediate relative (e.g. mother, father, son, daughter, brother or sister) of an employee of NIT Television or any affiliate, or any UK broadcaster.
- You understand that this is not a competition and that NIT is under no obligation to choose your written proposal to feature in the Programme and/or to select, develop or produce your written proposal as a television show or in any other way and may in its sole discretion reject your idea without giving any reasons for such decision.
- Written proposals must be wholly original to you, and not copied.
- Written proposals must not have been submitted to any other production company or broadcaster (whether as part of a competition or otherwise) and after submission you agree not to discuss with any third party, or publish, your written proposal unless you do not hear from NIT on or before 31/12/2017.
- Your written proposal will only be read by those persons who need to read it for its consideration to feature in the Programme. However, you understand and accept that in submitting your proposal you are not submitting it under a duty of confidence and that your written proposal is not confidential.
- You understand and accept that your written proposal may contain ideas and themes that are like ideas and themes which have been independently developed by NIT Television or other third parties without reference to your written proposal.
- You hereby agree not to institute any legal proceedings against NIT and/or any of its directors, staff, contractors or affiliates for any breach of confidence, infringement of copyright or for any other reason concerning your written proposal.
- If your written proposal is selected by NIT to feature in the Programme, you will be notified in writing and you will be required to enter into an agreement with NIT to license rights in your written

proposal to NIT on terms to be negotiated in good faith. NIT's decision shall be final and NIT will not enter into any correspondence with any unsuccessful applicant.

- If you have not heard from NIT on or before 31/12/2017 that will mean your written proposal has not be selected for the Programme. If your proposal is not chosen by NIT, all copies will be deleted or destroyed within a reasonable time period after receipt.
- Any breach of these Terms and Conditions by you may result in your written proposal not being considered by NIT and being deleted or destroyed.
- NIT will process your personal data in compliance with the Data Protection Act 1998 ("DPA") for the purpose of administering all matters relating to the consideration of your written proposal for a television show.
