Dear friends of Dante,

It's almost upon us! In just over three weeks the Festival Italiano — Auckland's biggest country-themed street festival — will open its gates in Newmarket, including, for the first time, in the Rialto Centre. Tens of thousands of Italy aficionados are expected to flock to the Festival, which will feature a rich offering of Italian culinary delights, products, live entertainment and events, including plenty of activities for the little ones. Pretty much everyone with an Italian connection will be there, including representatives of the Italian Consulate, the new Italian Ambassador, H.E. Fabrizio Marcelli, the Comites and Dante Alighieri staff, such as Dante's recently elected President Sir John Kirwan.

On a more somber note, you will probably have heard about the devastating earthquake in Central Italy on 24 August. The Consulate and the Comites will be organizing a collection for the victims of the earthquake at the Festival but if you don't want to wait until 25 September, you can donate now directly through the New Zealand Red Cross (see page 2).

So I hope to see you all in Newmarket in a few weeks' time and at all the various other events that will be held before and after the Festival.

## **CineClubDante in September**

Matteo's CineClubDante serie Italian murders and mysteries is back on Tuesday 27 September at 10am at Dante. We will watch Elio Petri's Indagine su un cittadino al di sopra di ogni sospetto (Investigation of a Citizen Above Suspicion), 1970, a dramatic psychological, black-humored satire on corruption in high office, telling the story of



a top police officer who kills his mistress, and then tests whether the police would charge him for this crime. The movie was highly regarded in its own time, winning the Academy Award for Best Foreign Language Film and both the FIPRESCI Prize and the Grand Prize at the 1970 Cannes Film Festival. Also it won as Best Foreign Language Film at the Kansas City Film Critics Circle Awards 1971 and the Edgard Award from the Mystery Writers of America for Best Mystery Screenplay. Indagine su un cittadino al di sopra di ogni sospetto was well received by critics and is widely considered one of the best international films of the 1970s. The New York Times called it "a suspense

melodrama with the moral concerns of angry satire... The story moves forward with a relentless momentum. It is a political parable, and a stunning movie." See you at Dante on Tuesday 27 September at 10am. Film in Italian language with Italian subtitles.
