Seasonal Camping Fees Fee: \$400 per season May – October

First payment: One Half (minimum Due on November 1st year prior)

Second Payment: Balance due by April 1st

If second payment is not received by April 1st, first payment is forfeited and the lot becomes available.

Note: Trailers may not remain on sites or campground during the off Season unless a \$200 storage fee is paid. Storage fee is due on November 1.

Guidelines for Seasonal Camping Memories

1. Season begins the middle of May and ends the middle of October.
2. Please assist in preserving the beauty of our campground by maintaining your site, debris and waste free and by keeping your lawn mowed.
3. Decks are allowed if made of treated lumber or patio blocks, do not exceed the dimensions of your awning and do not exceed a height of 4"
4. Decorating with flowers is allowed. Any trees or shrubs must be approved by the WPC&CC Board.
5. Rubbermaid storage sheds (one per site) are allowable if within the following dimensions:
6' High, 4'wide and 2' deep.
6. Seasonal Trailers must be a self-contained road worthy camping unit, which has a current license, and is insured.
7. One golf cart per site operated only by a licensed driver, with headlights, and must be insured and operated on roads only. Four wheel motorized units, such as: four wheelers, Gators, Rhinos, and etc, are not allowed to be driven on the Campground except for the purpose of helping and maintaining the Campground.
8. Tents are allowed for guests, but must be moved weekly to prevent killing the grass.
9. No Refrigerators outside of trailers are allowed.
10. Only one above ground fire ring allowed on each lot.
11. Must supply own picnic table.
12. Cannot Camp during CAMP 180 or Kids Camp
13. If you camp during the week of Family Camp, you will need to register with the Family Camp registrar. There will be no fee for camping; however, you will be charged a Ministry Fee, which you would pay to Family Camp registrar/treasurer at that time.
14. Please, Please, Please, NO DUMPING of gray or black water onto the ground!
15. To keep your Trailer on your site during the off season a \$200 storage fee will be charged to you. Trailers cannot stay on the Campground November 1st - April 30th without paying the \$200 storage fee.
