**NEW JERSEY COALITION AGAINST HUMAN TRAFFICKING  
SILHOUETTE PROJECT**

Welcome to the NJ Coalition Against Human Trafficking Silhouette Project! This program has been designed to encourage you to learn more about Human Trafficking and then raise awareness of modern-day slavery in your community.

**Here's what you do:**

1. Meet as a group and learn more about Human Trafficking locally, nationally, and internationally.
2. Decide what aspect of Human Trafficking you would like to focus on and raise awareness about.
3. Write a short paragraph describing who your silhouette represents and send it to Kathryn Irwin at [kirwin@jfedgmw.org](mailto:kirwin@jfedgmw.org) by February 15, 2016 in order to receive a silhouette. Silhouettes will be given out on a first come, first serve basis!
4. Design the embellishments for your silhouette and comment board.

**5. The Coalition provides these supplies:**

- Plywood silhouette
- 4 foot x 2 foot comment board
- 4 wooden "feet" to stand up your display
- Mylar that can be used to make shackles for hands or feet; that can bind your silhouette or be depicted as broken free

**Use your imagination and artistic flair. You can embellish your silhouette with paint, glued items, real clothing, paper mache, or anything else you want.**

6. Write your descriptive paragraph on the comment board. Decorate the comment board to match your silhouette if you choose, and allow space for passers-by to attach post-it notes with their comments and reactions.

Your group can be reimbursed for up to \$20 for supplies if you submit your sales receipts to the Coalition.

7. Display your silhouette at events and in public spaces in your school or community after you complete it.
8. Enter our competition for the best silhouettes at our Fair Trade Fair.

The Fair will take place on Sunday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> from 2-4 p.m., at County College of Morris in Randolph. Silhouettes will be judged on clarity of information, emotional expression, and craftsmanship. Winners will be determined by a combination of formal judging by professional artists and voting by Fair attendees. Winners will receive cash prizes to use to continue their Human Trafficking work.
