Call for Proposals

I. II ENEPI INVITATION

It's with great satisfaction that the UFRJ's Post Graduate Program in International Political Economy announces the realization of the II International Political Economy Meeting (II ENEPI, in Portuguese), that will be held on May 10th, 11th and 12th 2017 at the Institute of Economy, in Campus Praia Vermelha: 250 Av. Pasteur, ground floor, Urca - Rio de Janeiro, RJ – Brazil.

After the success of the first Meeting, that took place in May 2016, and the constant growth and consolidation of IPEs studies, converging with the recent manifestations and initiatives of Brazilian IPEs students and researchers, such as the IPE area at the Brazilian International Studies Association (ABRI, in Portuguese), the event seeks to strengthen the area's institutionalization efforts by offering a fertile and vibrant environment for ongoing, or concluded, research exhibition and debate as well as allowing a closer link between intellectuals (undergraduates, graduates students and professors/researchers) of different universities, research centers of Brazil and the world. We hope to promote the development of networks between these points allowing the debate of relevant topics to the area, such as the field of IPE in Brazil, the traditions of original thought in Brazil and Latin America, the research agenda, which topic is Development; and scientific and political influence of the knowledge produced in the area.

II. ABOUT PARTICIPATION

a) As Listeners.

The event is free and open to all those who wish to take part as listeners. There will be certificate for listeners the achieve, at least, 75% of certified attendance of all activities.

To participate as a listener, the interested party should e-mail to **enepi2017@gmail.com** entitled "Listener Registration" and provide the following information: Full name, academic training and institution.

b) As Paper Speakers.

Those who wish to present a paper shall send their proposal to **enepi2017@gmail.com** before February 3rd 2017. The proposal must be related in one of the five subject areas gathered by the Working Group:

WG 1. International System, Money and Finances

WG 2. Security, Defense and Geopolitics

WG 3. Development

WG 4. Foreign Policy, International Insertion and Regional Integration

WG 5. International Political Economy Theory and History

To present a paper, the author must be part of a research center or a graduate program (certificate, Master or PhD candidate) in the field of International Relations, IPE or related area, except for papers sent for the Undergraduate Forum.

The papers accepted for presentation will be announced on February 23rd 2017.

Not fulfilling any deadline or paper formatting will invalidate participation on the event as a paper speaker.

c) As an undergraduate student.

The Organizing Commission will select up to 10 undergraduate student papers to compose two specific debate panels. Those who are interested should follow the same procedure for proposal submission depicted bellow, replacing WG indication to Under Graduation Forum.

III. ABOUT SENDING PROPOSALS

1. Proposal's abstract must be related to one of the five subject areas gathered by the Working Groups, previously presented on this call.

2. The proposals must be presented as abstracts, according the following rules:

- a) Word File: .doc or .docx
- b) Page Size: A4
- c) Arial font and size 12 pt.
- d) Spaces between lines: 1,5.
- e) Abstract must contain header, author data, body of the text and key-words
- f) The body of the text must contain 300 words or less.

3. Header must contain:

- a) Event name in bold.
- b) Working group where the work should be placed.

c) Abstract title in bold.

4. Author Data must contain:

- a) Speaker (or speakers in case of co-authorship) name in bold
- b) Institution where the researcher belongs and if he receives scholarship

5. Each author can submit a maximum of two proposals, one as an author and one as co-author, being possible to submit two papers (author + co-author). The organizing commission gives itself the right to accept one or none of the presented proposals.

6. The organizing commission gives itself the right to redirect papers to other WGs, as it sees fit or due to a better fitting of the theme.

7. The abstract must be necessarily emailed before February 3rd to **enepi2017@gmail.com**. The e-mail subject field must contain:

- a) Working Group
- b) Author's name
- c) Paper's title.

d) e.g.: Subject: WG 1 – João Moreira da Silva – Brazil and the New Ways of Global Governance.

8. Don't forget to attach the abstract.

IV. ABOUT PAPER SPEAKER REGISTRATION FEE PAYMENT

- 1. The Registrations fee payment can be made after the proposal analysis results announcement on February 23rd 2017, and it can be made through bank deposit or transfer or credit card, directly through the event website.
- 2. Paper speakers must pay the registration fee with discount until the event day, regarding the stipulated dates. In case of lack of payment, the registration won't be confirmed and the speaker won't have the right to present their work.

3. Listeners and under graduation speakers are free of charge.

4. Proof of payments made by bank deposit or wiring must be e-mailed to **enepi2017@gmail.com**.

5. No refund will be given in case of giving up.

V. ABOUT SENDING COMPLETE PAPERS

1. the accepted paper must be in the following format:

- a) Word File: .doc or .docx
- b) Page: A4
- c) Font Arial and body 12 pt.
- d) Spaces between lines: 1,5.
- e) Text alignment: justified

2. Paper COVER must be the document produced as abstract, followed by a session break at the end of the COVER, so the body of the complete paper starts on the next page.

3. Complete body of the text must have:

- a) 20 pages maximum including illustrations, bibliography and end notes.
- b) Use ABNT rules for illustrations, bibliographic reference, tables and graphics.

4. The complete paper must be necessarily emailed before April 14th to **enepi2017@gmail.com**. The e-mail subject field must contain:

- a) Working Group

- b) Author's name
- c) Paper's title.
- d) e.g.: Subject: WG 1 – João Moreira da Silva – Brazil and the New Ways of Global Governance.

5. Don't forget to attach the paper.

VI. ABOUT PAPER PRESENTATION

1. Presentations will have around 15 to 20 minutes, defined by the Panel Chair, according to the daily schedule and/or participant number.

2. in case of needing any auxiliary equipment, e-mail the organizing commission information the request.

VII. ABOUT PAPER PUBLISHING

1. Every paper that follows the specified rules presented in this call, will be published through Annals, later.

2. The best papers, selected by the organizing commission and the scientific commission will be published at **Revista Oikos**, a semiannual journal that focus on stimulating original reflections and debates on social and economic development, IPE and Latin American integration.
