Denver, Colorado –This show is back by popular demand! 115 juried artists and craftsmen have been invited to showcase their work in the 3rd Annual Cheesman Park Art Fest, a selective, two-day art festival in one of Denver’s prized historic parks. Artists are hailing from across the nation for this event, this year representing 24 different states (including Colorado!). Best of all, participants were selected based on quality of work, variety of work *and* range of prices. The charming atmosphere and art experience that can be found at the Cheesman Park Art Fest is unmatched by any other event in the city. *There are no commercial sales or mass-produced items permitted; all work must be created by the artist who must also be present*. The Cheesman Park Art Fest was ranked as one of the ‘Top 14 Contenders for 2014’ out of all new art festivals in America by *Sunshine Artist Magazine*, an industry standard!

Location and Festival Features - The Cheesman Park Art Fest will take place on the southwest roads of Cheesman’s 80 acre green scape, close to 8th Avenue and Williams. Shoppers will have the chance to browse the works of potters, wood workers, painters, glass artists, jewelers, quilters, leatherworkers, sculptors, photographers, metalworkers and more, in a wide range of styles! The show also features **live music** on an intimate stage beneath the trees, eight of Denver’s best **food trucks**, and an array of ongoing **artist demonstrations**.

Handicapped friendly, special accommodations can be made. The RTD runs through the park and no bus routes will be disturbed by the festival.
