Simon Tedeschi is often described by respected critics and musical peers as one of the finest artists in the world making the young pianist's mark on music both undeniable and admirable. The versatility and scope of Tedeschi's appeal is exemplified by having shared the stage with numerous acclaimed musicians, including conductor Alan Gilbert, soprano Yvonne Kenny, jazz luminary James Morrison and Larry Adler the legendary Harmonica player who called Tedeschi 'the greatest pianist he ever heard.

He enjoys playing at Pearl Beach both classical and jazz. In recent years he has performed Jazz concerts with Kevin Hunt, Ian Cooper and in 2015 with vocalist Hetty Kate.

George Washingmachine is a multi-instrumentalist - proficient on double bass, guitar or anything with strings! He has hosted Jazz in the Domain several times, as well as The Darling Harbour Jazz Festival and presented concerts at The Thredbo Jazz Festival and the Taronga Park Zoo New Year's Eve Party. George has also worked in TV and radio, in his own right, and performs at numerous overseas Jazz Festivals.

George has played at Pearl Beach Jazz in January so is no stranger to the Arboretum. His quartet joins with jazz friend Simon for an afternoon of jazz delights.
