MARTIN BOGREN

Martin Bogren was born 1967 in Sweden and now lives in Malmö.

For the past ten years his work has evolved through long-term projects devoted to a personal approach. Martin's work is widely exhibited and won great recognition with the series "Tractor Boys" - 2013. He has published several monographs and is currently a member of Galerie VU' in Paris.

DESCRIPTION OF THE WORKSHOP

During four intense days you will work under the direction of Martin with an individual project, where the goal is to develop your personal language in your photography. You will photograph and edit a project and create a series that tells something, not only about someone else or somewhere else - but above all something about yourself.

This course focuses on content, rather than being a technical excuse to experience something. You will define your photographic language and learn to trust your intuition. Through personal feedback, discussions of the participants' ongoing work, class critiques and one to one reviews, the participants will develop a consciousness of their photography and its connection to themselves.

The first day of this workshop will be dedicated to inspiration, viewing Martin's work and processes, viewing each student's past work and discussing individual projects.

Participants are asked to prepare themselves with ideas of a possible project, as well as a portfolio of their previous work. If you have an ongoing long-term project to develop, or already have a clear idea, please bring it to the workshop. If not, you will be asked to formulate one on the first day of the course. By the end of the workshop, students will have been guided through and executing a personal project.

WHO IS THIS WORKSHOP FOR?

The workshop is aimed to professionals and advanced amateur photographers who want to develop their own visual language.

It will be held in English.

HOW WILL THE WORKSHOP TAKE PLACE?

The workshop will be intense and in order to get results, the participants will be expected to work on their individual projects from early morning until late in the evening.

Individual work and group discussions.

Daily projections of the works done.

Material required: a digital camera, a spare battery, a laptop and a pendrive.
