St. Patrick SUMMER QUEST provides opportunities for academic classes and exciting summer experiences. QUEST includes classes that cover basic review to strengthen academic skills and a variety of enrichment classes for children who wish to expand their learning in new areas. Registration is welcomed for boys and girls age four through thirteen.

REGISTRATION:

Complete all parts of the registration form and return with 1/2 of the tuition. The balance of the tuition is due by the first day of SUMMER QUEST on **June 6th**. Students will not be allowed in class on June 9th unless entire tuition has been paid. Tuition checks are made payable to St. Patrick School. Memo: Summer Quest 2016. ***Registration is on a first-come/first-served basis. A few classes are limited in enrollment.***

DEADLINES:

1/2 of the tuition is due at the time of registration. Full payment of tuition is due by the first day of classes on June 6th. NSF checks are assessed a **\$50.00** service fee.

WITHDRAWAL: Tuition for SUMMER QUEST will be refunded for withdrawals as follows:

75% through May 16, 2016

50% through May 31, 2016

25% through June 3, 2016

No refund after June 3, 2016

CANCELLATION: St. Patrick reserves the right to cancel a class if there is insufficient enrollment. Notice of such cancellation will be given to parents.

CONFIRMATION OF ENROLLMENT: The pink copy of the registration form with payment of 1/2 of tuition is confirmation of enrollment. The pink copy is your confirmation of classes. If you would like to change classes, please call St. Patrick School Office at 734-8979 ext. 222.

BRING YOUR REGISTRATION FORM ON THE FIRST DAY OF CLASSES!

ABSENCES: If your child is to be absent for SUMMER QUEST please call St. Patrick School Office 734-8979 ext 221 before 8:00am to state the reason for the absence. On returning to school after an absence, a student must bring a written note to the teacher from a parent or guardian.

TARDIES: Children who are tardy to SUMMER QUEST must report to the School Office before going to class. Students will be marked absent and parents will be called if their child's tardiness is not reported.

CLASS ATTENDANCE: Regular attendance is expected for all classes.

Incomplete (I) is given if a student has not mastered the minimum requirements in the subject area.

ASSIGNMENTS: Students are expected to complete all class and/or homework assignments. Students are responsible for seeing the teacher about make-up work after an absence from school.

ILLNESS IN SCHOOL: If a child becomes ill, the School Office will contact the family member listed on the Emergency Information Form to pick up the child. The office WILL NOT DISPENSE ANY MEDICATION.

PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES: If a parent wishes to arrange a conference with a teacher, contact the teacher directly OR call the School Office at 734-8979 ext. 222 to make an appointment with the teacher. Summer office hours are from 7:30am to 2:30pm.

PROGRESS REPORTS: SUMMER QUEST progress reports are given on June 23rd. Final Report Cards are distributed on July 8th. Students hand carry reports to parents. Copies are sent to the school in which the student is enrolled for the fall.

*******All tuition includes textbook rental and workbooks. Students must bring two #2 pencils, folder paper, folder, crayons, markers, scissors, and paste.**

CONDUCT: Students, teachers and staff are expected to conduct themselves in a caring, Christian manner. Students are expected to observe the following:

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

ART ENTHUSIASTS!

Do you love Art? Students have 5 weeks of drawing, painting, printmaking, and more! Students will work with Sharpies markers, watercolor, charcoal, and tempera paint while exploring design concepts and techniques. Limited Enrollment.

ANIMATION

Students will have fun reading their own interactive book. Students will use Power Point and digital cameras in a fun way to create games using their creativity, reading, and writing skills.

BEGINNING GOLF/TENNIS

Join the World of Sports! Students learn the fundamentals of golf for the first two and a half weeks. Fundamentals of tennis will take center stage for the last two and a half weeks of school. Students create a website highlighting their skills in golf and tennis.

BEGINNING ROBOTICS

Students learn the science and technology of robotics. Teams work together and incorporate the fundamentals of robotics using LEGO MindStorm. Limited Enrollment

INTERMDIATE ROBOTICS (Prerequisite: Beginning robotics)

Students must have prior knowledge of fundamentals of robotics. Teams will construct and operate more complex robotic models using LEGO MindStorm! Limited Enrollment

LANGUAGE ARTS 6 ~ LA 7 ~ LA 8

A reinforcement of basic grammar skills offered in grades 6-8. Students work on specific skill areas after pre-assessment test during the first two days. Grade 6 students review parts of speech (nouns, verbs, adverbs, adjectives); writing process; vocabulary; context clues). Grades 7th and 8th students review parts of speech (nouns, pronouns, verbs, adverbs, adjectives); vocabulary; writing process; words out of context; and analogies.

MATH 6 ~ MATH 7 ~ MATH 8

Sixth Graders will engage in activities that strengthen multiplication, division, decimals, word problems, mixed fractions and computational skills. Grades 7th and 8th work on decimals, mixed fractions, percent, ratio, problem solving, and pre-algebra concepts and skills.

OCEAN EXPLORATION

Special opportunity to learn about the least-explored place on earth---the Ocean. Explore the living and nonliving environments through a variety of hands-on activities. Learn about the most valuable resource we have----sustainability and environmental stewardship!

BASKETBALL AND SOCCER

BLOCK CLASSES

JrK Quest (8:00am to 12:10)

Open to INCOMING 4-Y/O. Children are introduced to their new school environment. Curriculum and activities designed to strengthen fine/gross motor skills, social and language skills as well as, counting sorting and patterning. Theme: **All Creatures BIG and TINY**

KIDS QUEST (8:00am to 12:10pm)

Open to INCOMING KINDERGARTENERS. Children strengthen social skills and adjust to a new learning environment. The curriculum reviews number sense, reading readiness skills through literature. Activities and curriculum are based on the theme **of All Creatures Great & Small.**

FIRST QUEST (8:00am to 12:10am)

FOR STUDENTS ENTERING FIRST GRADE. Children are introduced to the curriculum, environment, schedule and routine of the first grade. Curriculum and activities are based on the theme **of Ocean Mysteries.**

SECOND QUEST

An entire morning class (8:00am to 12:10pm) for **INCOMING SECOND GRADE CHILDREN ONLY.** Thematic, integrated curriculum for the 7-year-old child to strengthen and expand basic skills learned in the first grade. Activities and the curriculum are based on the theme of **Creepy Crawlers!**

THIRD QUEST

An entire morning class (8:00am to 12:10pm) for **INCOMING THIRD GRADE CHILDREN ONLY.** Enrichment and review activities for the 8-year-old child to strengthen and expand basic skills and get a jump start on Third Grade. The curriculum and activities are based on the theme of **Wild Things!**

FOURTH QUEST (8:00am to 12:10am)

FOR STUDENTS ENTERING FOURTH GRADE. Enrichment and review activities allow the 9-year-old child to strengthen and expand basic skills and get a jump-start on Fourth Grade. Activities and curriculum are based on the theme of **Friends of the Forest.**

FIFTH QUEST (8:00am to 12:10am)

FOR STUDENTS ENTERING FIFTH GRADE. Enrichment and review activities allow the 10-year-old child to strengthen math basic skills and get a jump-start on Fifth Grade. Activities and curriculum are based on the theme of **Our Living Planet.**
