# Our Lady and the Saints of France

**St. Bernadette, St. Catherine Labouré, St. Thérèse the Little Flower**

## **Day 1, Sunday, Oct. 19 – DEPART USA**

Overnight flight to Europe. Dinner and breakfast will be served on board.

## **Day 2, Monday, Oct. 20 – ARRIVE LOURDES**

Upon arrival in Europe you connect with your flight to Lourdes airport where you are greeted by your Grand View Tours guide and escorted to the vehicle which will then take you on a scenic ride to Lourdes. Upon arrival you check in to your hotel and relax before dinner with your group. Following dinner you may choose to participate in the Candlelight Procession before retiring for the evening.

## **Day 3, Tuesday, Oct. 21 – LOURDES**

We start the day with Mass at the Grotto, followed by a walking tour of Lourdes. You will see the places associated with the apparition of the Blessed Mother and walk in the footsteps of St. Bernadette. See Boly Mill where St. Bernadette was born, and the "Cachot," an abandoned prison where Bernadette's impoverished family lived. Join your prayers with those of pilgrims from around the world as you pray for the sick, drink water from the miraculous spring or submerge yourself in the healing baths. Again you have the opportunity to join the Candlelight Procession and group rosary with pilgrims from around the world.

## **Day 4, Wednesday, Oct. 22 – LOURDES**

We visit the new and old basilicas today, celebrate Mass at St. Anne's Chapel and pray with our group the Way of the Cross overlooking the holy Grotto. The rest of the day is at leisure with personal time devoted to prayer and reflection. This is our last evening to join the spectacular Candlelight Procession, with pilgrims from around the world and pray the rosary and sing hymns in honor of the Mother of God.

## **Day 5, Thursday, Oct. 23 - LOURDES to PARIS**

We begin our day with breakfast before our transfer to the train station where we board the TGV train. Upon arrival in Paris, we are transferred to the hotel. We check-in to our hotel with time to relax before our afternoon visit to Notre Dame Cathedral. We continue on a panoramic tour of the beautiful city of Paris, including the Champs Elysée, the Arc de Triomphe, Eiffel Tower and other famous Paris landmarks before dinner at a local restaurant.

## **Day 6, Friday, Oct. 24 – PARIS**

After breakfast and a good night's sleep we begin our day with a visit to Rue du Bac where we will visit the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal and view the incorrupt body of St. Catherine Labouré whose guardian angel led her to the chapel where the Blessed Virgin displayed a vision of the miraculous medal and later the green scapular. The Virgin promised bountiful graces for all who wore these. We continue on our way which includes a visit to the chapel of St. Vincent De Paul and Mass at the Sacre Coeur Basilica, located in the Montmartre section of Paris. We finish our tour around lunch time leaving the rest of the day at leisure.

## **Day 7, Saturday, Oct. 25 – NEVERS**

After an early breakfast we travel by way of the picturesque Loire Valley to St. Gildard Convent in Nevers where St. Bernadette lived for 13 years as a member of the Congregation of the Sisters of Nevers. We will have time to reflect before the body of Bernadette, seeing, the face that 18 times looked on the Virgin Mary, the hands that, at the request of the Blessed Virgin, had scraped the ground and allowed the spring to flow at the back of the Grotto, the lips that related the words of the Immaculate Virgin and the Message of Lourdes. We return to Paris this afternoon for dinner and overnight.

## **Day 8, Sunday, Oct. 26 – LISIEUX, ST. THERESE THE LITTLE FLOWER**

After breakfast, we depart for Lisieux where we will enjoy a tour of the home of St. Therese whom Pope Pius X called 'the greatest saint of modern times.' Her extraordinary love for God and service to humanity comes alive as you visit the Basilica of Saint Therese, one of the biggest and most magnificent religious structures built in the 20th-century. While in Lisieux we will celebrate Mass. We will make a stop at Les Buissonnets, St. Therese's family home. You will see on display relics, clothing and personal object belonging to the 'little flower.' Before leaving we tour the ancient Cathedral of St. Peter and the Carmelite Convent. We return to Paris for dinner and overnight.

## **Day 9, Monday, Oct. 27 – DEPART FROM PARIS**

After breakfast, we transfer to Paris airport for your return flight home.
