
Why should you go? It's simple: your marriage will be impacted in a deeply meaningful and powerful way. After this pilgrimage, you and your spouse will:

Day 1, Sunday, Oct. 19 – DEPART USA FOR PARIS Overnight flight to Paris.

Day 2, Monday, Oct. 20 – PARIS – ALENÇON

Bonjour and welcome to France! After claiming your baggage and exiting the baggage claim area we meet our English speaking tour manager who will assist us as we board our motor coach. We travel to **Alençon** (2 hour drive) home of Blessed Louis and Zélie Martin and their nine children, the last one being little Thérèse (Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus.) We begin our retreat with opening prayer by Deacon Harold Burke-Sivers our host and retreat director followed by lunch. Relax and rest before joining your group for an afternoon walk through the town of the Martin family. We will celebrate Mass in the chapel of the Martin home, enjoy dinner with our group followed by prayer and reflection with Deacon Harold.

Day 3, Tuesday, Oct. 21 – SHRINE OF ALENÇON

Breakfast this morning before we gather with Deacon

Harold for a talk in preparation for our day following the footsteps of Blesseds Louis and Zélie Martin. We visit and tour their home, **Les Buissonets**, including the birth room of Therese, the chapel and relics of Blessed Louis and Zélie. Alençon has kept the memory of the Martin family whose fate was both fascinating and outstanding. When she was 26 years old, Zélie Guerin passes Louis Martin on the **Sarthe Bridge** in Alençon and had a premonition *"This is whom I have prepared for you."* The wedding took place a few months after their meeting, on July 13 1858. Continuing on we cross the Sarthe bridge where Louis and Zélie first met, see Louis Martin's clock shop and the couple's first home. Later this afternoon we celebrate a special Mass

and **renewal of marriage vows** in the **Basilica of Notre Dame**; where Louis and Zélie were married, St. Thérèse was baptized and where Zélie's funeral was held. Dinner this evening with our group followed by small group sharing.

Day 4, Wednesday, Oct. 22 – MONT-SAINT-MICHEL

We celebrate Mass in the chapel of the Martin family home before our breakfast and departure for a full day excursion to Le Mont Saint Michel. It was here that Aubert, Bishop of d'Avranches, founded a sanctuary on Mont-Tombe, after 3 successive appearances by the Archangel Michael. Consecrated in **709**, the church has attracted pilgrims from all over the world ever since. After having been made into a prison from the time of the French Revolution up until the time of the Second Empire, the Abbey became the responsibility of the Historical Monuments Department in **1874**. Since **1969** the Abbey has been home to a monastic community, ensuring the continuation of a spiritual presence. Rightly called "**The Wonder of the Western World**", the Mont-Saint-Michel is surrounded by a magnificent bay, which is the theatre of the **greatest tidal ranges in Europe**, offering a spectacular view. The Mont-Saint-Michel is an international place of pilgrimage as well as a major tourist center. The different stages of its construction have created a unique architectural ensemble which was classified as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1979. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 5, Thursday, Oct. 23 – LISIEUX – NOTRE DAME SANCTUARY OF MONTLIGEON



After breakfast we bid farewell to Alençon with a grateful heart and renewed spirit as we depart for **Lisieux** where we will enjoy a tour of the home of St. Thérèse whom Pope Pius X called "the greatest saint of modern times." Her extraordinary love for God and service to humanity comes alive as we visit the **Basilica of Saint Thérèse**, one of the biggest and most magnificent religious structures built in the 20th-century. While in Lisieux Mass will be celebrated. Before leaving, tour the ancient **Cathedral of St. Peter** and the **Carmelite Convent**. This is the cathedral where Thérèse participated in the life of the local Church during her youth. For ten years Thérèse came here every Sunday and often during the week with her father and sisters to attend Mass. After our visit we continue on to the beautiful Perche region where the **Shrine of Our Lady of Montligeon** welcomes us. Dinner this evening followed by an

introduction to the rich history of the Sanctuary.

Day 6, Friday, Oct. 24 – NOTRE DAME SANCTUARY OF MONTLIGEON - PARIS

A true cathedral in the fields, the Sanctuary is a perfect setting for our retreat offering a time of quiet rest in this naturally beautiful area. A global center of prayer for the deceased, the Sanctuary aims to offer spiritual comfort suitable for all the suffering that life can bring. Deacon Harold has planned a special program for our group. Following the program there we will celebrate Mass. After lunch we depart for Paris with time to relax and rest before dinner this evening at a local restaurant.



Day 7, Saturday, Oct. 25 - PARIS

This morning we celebrate Mass at the **Chapel of the Miraculous Medal** where we see the incorrupt body of St. Catherine of Labouré. It was here where Our Lady appeared to St. Catherine in 1830. Later we visit Sacred Heart Cathedral, located in the Montmartre section of Paris; a fun area to explore on your own. Rest of the day is at leisure. Dinner with our group followed by a special talk by Deacon Harold.

Day 8, Sunday, Oct. 26 - PARIS

We begin our day with mass followed by a leisurely breakfast. Today enjoy a panoramic tour of Paris including **Champs Elysee, Arc de Triomphe and Eiffel Tower**. Free time for lunch on your own before a visit and tour of **Notre Dame Cathedral**. We return to our hotel early this afternoon allowing time to pack and prepare for your morning departure. A farewell dinner is planned this evening

Day 9, Monday, Oct. 27 – DEPART PARIS TO USA

This morning you are transferred to the airport for your flight home
