DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

(Note: B=breakfast; D=dinner)

June 21 DAY 1: DEPART U.S.A.

Depart on your overnight flight to Paris.

June 22 DAY 2: PARIS

Welcome to France. You are greeted by your tour escort and transferred to the hotel. This afternoon you have a panoramic tour of Paris, including the Champs Elysée, the Arc de Triomphe, Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame Cathedral, and St. Vincent DePaul which we visit. Mass this afternoon. Overnight Paris. (D)

June 23 DAY 3: PARIS

This morning we celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal where Our Lady appeared to St. Catherine Laboure in 1830 and visit Sacred Heart Cathedral, located in the Montmartre section of Paris; a fun area to explore on your own. Rest of the day is at leisure or you may wish to take an optional tour to Versailles, the summer residence of King Louis IX. Overnight Paris (B,D)

June 24 DAY 4: NEVERS - PARIS

After breakfast we depart for Nevers by way of the picturesque Loire Valley. In order to fulfill her desire for a religious life, Bernadette arrived at St Gildard, the house of the Sisters of Charity on July 7, 1866 where she stayed for 13 years. Her simple and ordinary life was entirely consecrated to God in a chapel in the garden. Bernadette died at age 35. See her incorrupt body miraculously preserved since her death in 1879. We return to Paris early evening. (B,D)

June 25 DAY 5: PARIS – LOURDES

We begin our day with Mass before our transfer to the train station where we board the TGV train. Upon arrival in Lourdes, we are transferred to the hotel. Tonight you have the opportunity to join the Candlelight Procession. Overnight Lourdes. (B,D)

June 26 DAY 6: LOURDES

You start the day with Mass at the Grotto, followed by a walking tour of Lourdes. You will see the places associated with the apparition of the Blessed Mother and life of little Bernadette. There will be a pilgrim-age schedule set, which includes comprehensive spiritual activities. You have the opportunity to bathe in the Baths, where miraculous cures

have taken place, pray the Stations of the Cross, attend the Blessing of the Sick and in the evening join the spectacular Candlelight Procession, where thousands of visitors pray the rosary and sing hymns in honor of the Mother of God. Overnight Lourdes. (B,D)

June 27 DAY 7: LOURDES

We visit the new and old basilica today, celebrate Mass and pray the Stations of the Cross. The rest of the day is devoted to prayer and reflection. Overnight Lourdes. (B,D)

June 28 DAY 8: LOURDES – LOYOLA - BURGOS

After breakfast we depart for Loyola, birthplace of St. Ignatius, found of the Jesuits. Here we will see the 17th century Basilica dedicated to St. Ignatius. We will have time to pray and celebrate Mass at the Chapel of Conversion, the most venerated room where Ignatius at age 30 was brought following his serious wounding at the Battle of Pamplona. Time for lunch before continuing on to Burgos where we will visit the magnificent Cathedral. Overnight Burgos (B,D)

June 29 DAY 9: BURGOS - FATIMA

Mass this morning before we depart from Spain to Portugal. Arrive in Fatima in time for dinner and to participate in the Candlelight and Blessed Sacrament Procession. Overnight Fatima. (B,D)

June 30 DAY 10: FATIMA

Our walking tour includes visiting Aljustrel, where the children lived, and Valinhos, site of Our Lady's Appearance. Also, the Basilica and the tombs of the children on the Cove da Ira. Mass is scheduled at the Little Chapel of Apparitions. Tonight participate in the Candlelight and Blessed Sacrament Procession. Overnight Fatima. (B,D)

July 1 DAY 11: SANTAREM - FATIMA

Celebrate Mass at the Basilica, pray the Way of the Cross, see the Chapel of St. Stephen and Lucia's Well, where the Angel spoke to the children. Afternoon visit to Santarem and Church of the Holy Miracle; the oldest recorded Eucharistic Miracle on continuous display since 1269AD. Overnight Fatima. (B,D)

July 2 DAY 12: RETURN TO THE USA

Transfer to the airport for your flight home. (B)
