If your bird does not resemble a standard color, please enter it as "AOV (all other varieties)". Birds will be cooped according to color. You may opt out of in-cage judging if you wish. The in cage show is included with tabletop fees.

The Tabletop show will be a "color-blind" show, using the ASA standard of perfection for the American Serama.
