

## 2013 Wild West Serama Classic



**Location:** Ramona Junior Fairgrounds, 431 Aqua Lane, Ramona CA

**Date/Time:** Saturday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, 9am- 5pm, In cage judging begins at 9am sharp.

For out of town guests, we have arranged for birds to be kept overnight at the fairgrounds. There is no requirement keep birds overnight, they are just the arrangements we've made for travelers' convenience. Coop in Friday 4-8pm, Coop out Sunday 7-9am.

The Serama In-Coop show will be held first. If your bird resembles a standard color, like Mottled, or Wheaten, for instance, please enter that under "Color Variety". If your bird does not resemble a standard color, please enter it as "AOV (all other varieties)". Birds will be cooped according to color. You may opt out of in-cage judging if you wish. The in cage show is included with tabletop fees.

The Tabletop show will be a "color-blind" show, using the ASA standard of perfection for the American Serama.
