

CAMP SALMEN NATURE PARK RULES

Park grounds and facilities (pavilions and amphitheater) are available on a first come, first served basis for casual use (for example: picnics). Please limit use to two hours so others may enjoy.

Formal gatherings, special events and private party celebrations (birthday parties, company picnics, weddings, family reunions, etc.) in the amphitheater or in either pavilion require a reservation and payment at least a week in advance plus a \$25 refundable deposit. Please ask Park Ranger, call the office or find rental forms in the information binder in the Main Pavilion.

We ask all trash and food scraps be picked up. Please report spills and any problems with the restrooms.

NO barbecuing, grilling, open fires, camping, alcohol, glass containers, metal detectors, pets, litter (including confetti, piñatas, tinsel, water balloons, etc.), damage to plants, disturbing wildlife, business solicitation, trespassing off park property, swimming, fishing, excessively noisy disturbance, motorized vehicles driving or parking off-road, on grass, tree roots, bicycle or foot paths. Do not block access to entrances.

All tent stakes must be removed (count them in and count them out).

All children under the age of twelve are required to have adult supervision. Children attending events/parties must be hand-delivered by an adult to the reserved area and chaperoned during the event.

Shoes must be worn at all times.

Pets are NOT allowed in the park or on the Tammany Trace.
