

OREGON GROWN ORCHIDS

FLASKS

The following flasks contain 25 to 30 seedlings that are ready to be potted out. They are shipped in bottle and should be potted out upon arrival. We recommend the seedlings be treated with Thiram for the first week or two, after that we begin fertilizing weekly as they are off and running.

HP276 Paph. <i>charlesworthii</i> ('Pink Fan' x 'Dark') The cultivar 'Pink Fan', is from Orchid Inn, album breeding. The clone 'Dark', is Orchid Zone breeding. The 'Pink Fan' clone has superb shape and is one of the best <i>charlesworthii</i> we have seen. Good variety is expected from this outcross. (3) flasks available \$ 150.00
 HP281 Paph. (Olympic Halo 'Sol' x Sorcerer's Stone 'Yellow Desire') A cross for more yellow complex Paphiopedilums. We love the yellow slippers and there are just not enough of them. We hope this cross will produce some very fine large yellow slippers. (5) flasks available \$ 150.00

The following hobby community pots contain 10 - 15 vigorous growing seedlings ready to pot up to individual 2" and 2.25" pots. They are in limited supply.



HP-183 Paph. Olympic Emerald ('Hemlock' AM/AOS x 'Hillsview' AM/AOS) A sib cross between two of the best clones. Expectations are high for some outstanding large green complex big full dorsal and ventral sepals on these. Hobby Community Pots \$ 50.00

HP-194 Paph. (Olympic Emerald 'Hillsview' AM/AOS x charlesworthii album 'Titan' AM/AOS) Exceptional charlesworthii novelty hybrids are stunning. We expect nothing less from this grex. Hobby Community Pots \$ 75.00
 259 Paph. wolterianum ('Pink Wings' x 'Victoria') While Paph. wolterianum is considered Paph. appletonianum, this is a sib cross between two stunning examples of the once type species Paph. wolterianum. Hobby Community Pots \$ 50.00
