Should I dress up?

How early should I arrive before my start time?

Please arrive at least an hour before your start time to ensure you get to the starting gate on time.

Will there be parking when I arrive?

We will have parking on site. Parking will be \$10.00 per car and proceeds taken from parking will be donated to our Charity Partner: TBA

Where do I go to register my name?

When you have arrived, follow the registration signs.

What do I need when registering?

Please make sure you have your Booking receipt, drivers license or I.D. to verify your booking.

Where can I leave my belongings?

A bag drop facility will be available onsite, our staff will collect your belongings at the bag drop area, tag them and store them safely during your time on the course. Bag drop services are only \$2 and paid through the online booking process.

Will there be any merchandise for sale during the event?

We will be setting up a cool online merchandise page very soon, so you can remember and have a laugh about Obstacles Gone Mad! for a long, long time to come. You can collect what you order on the day of the event.

Merchandise will be available on the day, however there will be limited stocks available.

Will there be food and drink on sale?

Yes, we will have food and drink vendors on site.

Will I have something to do other than on the course?

Yes you will. We will have a festival area set up for your entertainment. Pop in and say hi to our sponsors and vendors.

Can I purchase alcohol at Obstacles Gone Mad!?

Will there be water stations on the Obstacles Gone Mad! course?
