Come join us this summer when a professional staff of three will cast and produce a revival of Prairie Fire Children's Theatre's popular production of *Robin Hood*. This one week camp will culminate in three performances at West Central Area Secondary School in Barrett, Minnesota.

WHY

The Prairie Fire Children's Theatre day camp provides a rare opportunity for young people and teens from a wide range of backgrounds to come together and produce an original theatrical event. Since the first day camp was held in 1987, over 1,500 registrants have been involved, representing more than 120 communities and nine states.

WHO

Anyone age seven to 18 is eligible. All registrants are guaranteed a part in the play and participation in the workshop schedule. Registration is held on a first come, first served basis.

The camp offers an intense theatrical experience in a very short period of time. In addition to the daily rehearsal schedule, campers will also participate in theatrical workshops.

FEE SCHEDULE

\$100 for former campers and \$120 for new campers. Limited partial scholarships are available. Please inquire at (320) 528-2596.

Out of town campers whose housing is found through Prairie Fire, add \$30. Out of town campers are also responsible for a \$75 meal/transportation payment to the host family.

Originally from Wisconsin, Deborah has made her home in Minnesota since attending the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis. After moving to the prairies of Minnesota, Deborah began to concentrate her talents on children's theatre. She collaborated on creating a children's touring program for her county's community theatre, directing the first two productions in 1984 and 1985. She went on to tour professionally throughout the western United States and Canada in a children's production of *The Wizard of Oz*, as an actress and director. Upon returning home, she co-founded the Prairie Fire Children's Theatre. Deborah oversees the artistic direction of Prairie Fire Children's Theatre, collaborating on the development of scripts and music, and designing sets and costumes.

JEREMY DAY


Spencer, WI — Managing Director

He was the head director for the *Aladdin* camp in 2012, the *Pinocchio* camp in 2013, and the *Snow White* camp in 2014. He will delight audiences this year as the bumbling Sheriff of Nottingham in *Robin Hood*.


