

## **Benny Hinn, 2007, on Demonology**

It is time to use the power that Jesus gave us!

Luke 10:19; I give you power- satan no longer has the power. All power is Mine, in heaven and in earth. No power belongs to satan.

Jesus is our Joshua- we must possess the land.

The devil's victory depends on our ignorance. My people perish for lack of knowledge.

Isa. 61: When God saved my soul He did not destroy my will.

Eph. 4:27; give no place to the devil

Romans 6:16; we choose liberty over bondage

We are born with at least one weakness it does not disappear at salvation. God gave us authority over that weakness. A lie has a very short life but the truth has a long life.

II Peter 2:19; I Peter 5:8,9, James 4:7, Psa. 17:4, Psa. 119:1,2, Prov. 5:23, Ecc. 8:5

Where there is bondage, the Word of God is lacking. Where there is no Word, there is sin, where there is Word, no sin.

II Tim. 2:25,26, with meekness, unlock the chains of sin around someone's neck.

With meekness instruct. Give them the Word

Jeremiah 23:29; cracks the heart of bondage out of their life, brings them to repentance.

### **Signs of Demonic activity putting us in bondage**

These 7 steps begin with **rebellion**; I Sam.16:14, total takeover.

All these steps took place in King Saul.

1. Regression- returning to old behavior
2. Repression- murmur and complaining repress praise, no joy, blame God for things that God had nothing to do with.

3. Suppression- conceals their experience with Jesus; use only the name of God. Jesus becomes an embarrassment
4. Depression- hopelessness, all hope is lost.
5. Oppression- completely over-powered by the devil. The devil takes control, II Tim. 2:26, in bondage
6. Obsession- surrounded by demons, besieged, almost to the point of no return, almost unable to call for help. Prayer life is choked.
7. Possession- total destruction.

- **Jesus is the only way out of any of these stages!!**
- **Up to depression, it is a partnership, but after depression it is a take over.**
- **One of the most powerful weapons against the enemy is Worship.**

### **Things leading into the 7 steps of the demonic:**

1. **Rebellion**
2. **Their tongue;** listen to what they say, Prov. 13:3, Eph. 3:10, angels discover God when they watch and observe and listen to a believer.
3. **A critical spirit-** Psa. 10:1-5, II Tim. 2;16,17. Doors that open the way into bondage, **fear**, I John 4:18, Eph. 4
4. **Unforgiveness-** Matt. 18:34,35, Mark 11:25
5. **Involvement with demonic activity** like movies, games, objects, etc. Lev.19:31, 20;6-8, Joshua 7:1, 10-12

### **The tongue:**

1. The understood language
2. Tongues- prayer language, I Corinthians 14
3. Tongues- gift of tongues, equal to prophecy

1. Discernment
2. Knowledge
3. Word of Wisdom

### Vocal Gifts

1. Tongues
2. Interpretation of Tongues

### **Twelve strongmen in the Bible where demonic activity exists**

1. **Spirit of jealousy**- anger, rage, revenge, murder, competition, suspicion, vengeance. Scriptures: Numbers 5:11-14, Proverbs 6:34,35
2. **Lying spirit**- religious spirits, filthy, controlling, stubbornness, and forcefulness. Scriptures: II Chron. 18:22, Jeremiah 23:14-16, Exo. 12:24
3. **A familiar spirit**-divination, acts holy, astrology, the occult. Scriptures: I Samuel 28:7, Deut. 18:10:12
4. **A perverse spirit**-hates God, lives in error, twist the Word of God to fit them, lust, homosexuals, lesbian – it is such a strong demon it will not come

out with just the name of Jesus because it uses the Bible to prove it right. The presence of Jesus must be evident; there must be tangible substance for the demon to flee. Scriptures: Isa. 19:14, Prov. 14:2, Acts 13:10, Prov. 23:33.

5. **Spirit of whoredom**- prostitution, idolatry, everything they say is a lie and it is perversion, those that watch soap operas, any form of worship other than Jesus. Scriptures: Hosea 4:12, Eze.16:28-39.
6. **Spirit of heaviness**- gloom, depression, grief, gluttony, self pity, despair, hopelessness, rejection (abused emotionally). Scriptures: Isa. 61:3.
7. **Spirit of infirmity**- all sickness. Scripture; Luke 13:11. Jesus loosed her.
8. **Deaf and dumb spirit**- epilepsy, seizures, anorexia, suicide, lunatic, insanity, (tears himself). Scriptures: Mark 9:17-25, Matt. 17:14-15.
9. **Spirit of fear**- torment, terror, inferiority complex, phobias, nightmares. Scriptures: II Tim.1:7, Job 4:14.
10. **Spirit of pride**- fighting, contentions, wrath, self-righteous, control. Scriptures: Prov. 16:18, 13:10, 21:24.
11. **Spirit of bondage**- all addictions, cigarettes, alcohol, drugs, sex, etc. Scriptures: Rom. 8:15.
12. **Spirit of antichrist**- any spirit that exalts itself above Christ, putting themselves in the place of Christ

God is Good, He is a forgiving and a healing God. Scripture: Acts 10:38

- He is good and upright
- Taste and see that the Lord is good
- The Lord heals his people
- James 1:17, nothing evil in God, every good & perfect gift comes from God.

- Jesus went about healing and doing good
- Healing is good and good is healing
- When I confess my sin, I will be cleansed
- Along the way sickness and disease will touch my body, but God will heal me. I will sin, but God will forgive me
- Know the healing nature of God, the healing nature of Jesus
- I am the God that heal-eth thee. Exo. 15:26
- Healing is as easy to pray for as forgiveness
- 70 years of health, and if strong 80; Psalm 90:10, Psa. 102:24
- Your sins are forgiven, take your bed rise up and walk. Matt. 9:6
- Is any among you sick? James 5
- Jesus Christ is the will of God in action
- Man is spirit and substance in nature, Isa. 33:24
- Healing is my covenant right; forgiveness is my covenant right
- The preaching of the Gospel and healing are twins; always go together
- Sin and disease are also connected
- He is the Messiah; Matt. 4:23-25
- There is the front of the cross; salvation and the back side of the cross; healing
- Healing is the fruit of redemption; Acts 4:10, 4:12
- Healing in the atonement
- The name of Jesus brings salvation and healing
